

# From the Desk of Father George

Greetings parishioners and friends of St. Julie's,

This weekend the Gospel offers some rather shocking words as Jesus encounters the Canaanite woman who was seeking healing for her daughter. In so many words, Jesus refers to her as nothing better than a dog... but the woman's faith shakes off the insult and Jesus heals her daughter. Of course, we need to understand the separation of tribes and nations to begin to understand the comment. Jesus often crossed the boundaries of his day and used it to teach us a lesson. Today, the Canaanite woman is the instrument of God's grace!

How great is our faith? Is it great enough to trust that God loves and cares for each of us? Is it great enough to cause us to go beyond barriers that separate us from one and other? Is it great enough to realize that God's mercy is for all who turn toward him?

Weekly we come to celebrate our faith... to give glory and honor to God and to be strengthened in His grace for the week to come. We first acknowledge that we are sinners - one and all - and then are fed by the Scripture selections. Through both Word and Eucharist we are to be changed... to be opened - to be broken for one and other.

Take some time to focus upon the person or persons toward whom you need to be opened. God desires to heal that relationship and He needs YOU. Is your faith great enough?




