

In their synagogue was a man with an unclean spirit; he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God!" Jesus rebuked him and said, "Quiet! Come out of him!"

- Mk 1:23-25

From the Desk of Father George

Greetings Parishioners and friends of St. Julie's,

*"What do you want with us, Jesus of Nazareth? ...
I know who you are - the Holy One of God!"*

These powerful words from today's gospel are from the man who appeared in the synagogue with an unclean spirit. That unclean spirit shrieked in challenge and fear of Jesus. It was a confrontation to Jesus, but yet also the avenue whereby the teaching and authority of Christ was made manifest to those present. Throughout the ages we have been called to live not only as people of faith, but people of truth. How do the teachings and authority of Jesus direct our choices? Are others aware through our word and deeds that we know Jesus as the Holy One of God?

Moses spoke to the people about a prophet in their midst. Do we hear the voices still echoing across the ages... that God desires us to live in His truth... that Jesus is the Holy One of God... and that we are obliged to seek and declare Him to the world? Being a disciple - a follower of Jesus, demands response of the appropriate nature to both the truths and teachings of our church. Continue to discover what that means by doing some research, some reading and most of all prayer during these winter days.
