Dear St. Julie Parishioners,

As most of you know, I have been appointed the administrator of St. Julie Parish while Fr. George is on medical leave. We pray that the procedures he will undergo over the next few months will be a source of healing and strength for him.

I will continue my work as pastor of St. Peter Parish and the Bishop's Delegate to Catholic Renewal Ministries. Fr. Andrew Hoover (the parochial vicar at St. Peter Parish) and I hope to serve you well during this time. What can you expect?

First of all, neither Fr. Andrew nor I have perfected the art of being in two places at once. St. Peter Parish has five weekend Masses (six, if we include our Saturday morning Mass). We will do our best to be present for some of the weekend Masses at St. Julie's. However, there will be other priests from the area assisting on the weekends for the celebration of the Eucharist.

As for other sacraments: Confessions at St. Julie's will be held on the second Saturday of the month. At other times I ask that St. Julie parishioners go to nearby parishes to celebrate the Sacrament of Penance. St. Peter Parish has confessions on Saturday afternoon from 3:30 to 4:30 PM and on Fridays after the 8:15 AM Mass. Confessions are normally done by 9:15 AM.

If you need the Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick, please call the office at St. Julie Parish (440-327-1978). If this is after office hours, please call the office at St. Peter Parish (440-327-2201).

In addition to the sacraments, I hope to be a part of your Parish Council and Finance Council meetings.

I enjoyed celebrating your 40th Anniversary last weekend with your annual outdoor Mass. In biblical terms, 40 is a number that symbolizes completeness. After 40 years in the desert, the Israelites entered the Promised Land. After 40 days of fasting in the desert, Jesus began his public ministry. I pray that these 40 years of service as a parish is but a prelude to proclaiming Jesus Christ in deed and word in new and more profound ways.

This Sunday's gospel presents us with two sets of disciples. The first set is those who stopped following Jesus. He was too much for him. His teachings stretched them too far. The second set is represented by Peter. When asked, "Will you also leave?" Peter responded, "Lord, to whom shall we go? You have the words of everlasting life...we believe that you are the Holy One of God." Let us answer with Peter and faithfully confess Jesus Christ, God's Son, our Savior and Lord by word and deed.
