Getting There: GPS Info. (Latitude, Longitude): 32.53833, -110.71639 32°32'18"N, 110°42'59"W



From Phoenix/Tempe:drive east on **US-60 East**/Superstition Fwy to **AZ Hwy 79** (Exit 212, signs for Florence/Tucson). Turn

right (**south**) and go 58.2 miles (through Florance) to **AZ Hwy-77**. Turn left (**east**) and go 9.1 miles. Turn right onto W. American Avenue (signs for Oracle). **Gas up in Oracle.** Go 2.4 miles and turn right onto the East Mt. Lemmon Hwy. Go 3.2 miles and take the slight right and continue 5.0 miles. The campground is on the left.

From Tucson: drive north on Oracle Road (AZ Hwy 77 for 36 miles to the town of Oracle. Take the first Oracle exit . American Avenue (signs for Oracle). **Gas up in Oracle.** Go 2.4 miles and turn right onto the East Mt. Lemmon Hwy. Go 3.2 miles and take the slight right and continue 5.0 miles. The campground is on the left.

The Peppersauce Campground Group Campsite is reserved. Follow the big, pink "CAG ARA" signs. We will **be completing the Peppersauce graffiti removal and restoration project** at the ARA. We are well into the Rabbit Hole Maze and removed graffiti from the Book Room in August. There are several caves on the north side of Mt. Lemon so recreational trips will also be going out. Saturday night dinner will be from **Nonna Maria's Pizza** in Oracle. The ARA meeting will be Saturday night around the campfire.
