# **Household Hazardous Waste (HHW)**

workrooms, basements, tool sheds and garages. HHW materials should not be the environment. Common HHW products can be found under the sink, in closets or an irritant that when disposed of improperly poses a threat to human health and HHW is any product labeled as toxic, poisonous, corrosive, flammable, combustible placed in the trash, poured down the drain or into storm drains, or burned.
