“NEWS FROM OUR CHURCHES”

Bethany: The saints at Bethany anticipated the arrival of Spring with a fruitful month of ministry. John Battaglia of Capitol Commission Ministries in Jefferson City preached on March 10, updating us on his ministry to our state leaders in the capitol. We hosted and helped the Central Missouri Food Bank's food truck on the 13th. Our Young Adults enjoyed a fellowship on the 16th, complete with BBQ and all the fixens! The saints observed the Lord's Supper to conclude our morning worship, then welcomed new members, on March 17. On the 19th the ladies started their Spring Bible study of "God of Covenant," by Jen Wilkin's a study in the second half of Genesis. These studies will be held on Tuesday evenings at 6:30 at the church; any interested ladies are welcome to attend. The Ladies Fellowship will meet Thursday the 28th at El Tapatio at 6:00. We've planned a workday for March 30th to prepare us to relocate Sunday School back to our remodeled Fellowship Building on April 7. Pastor Bowen attended the annual Shepherd's Conference on March 4-9. He continues his Sunday expositions of Hebrews (morning) and Ecclesiastes (evenings).

Bethlehem: Our Pastor had a birthday this month, Happy Birthday Pastor Jason!! Our teens are working very hard on fund-raising for their upcoming conference for teens in Branson the first weekend in April. We will be learning about Christ and having fun with other church teens. What a great bonding experience. We have one church member in Honduras on a mission trip. We ask for prayers for a safe return for their group. We will be doing a food drive for the month of April to benefit different Pantries in Sedalia. We are calling it missions at home. Happy Spring and God Bless

Broadway: We look forward to April and celebrating another Resurrection Weekend including a Good Friday service with The Lord's Supper. Christians should use RESURRECTION SUNDAY, NOT EASTER. The Resurrection is the foundation of our faith (John 11:24-27; Acts 4:33; 23:6-11; 1 Corinthians 15:12-42; 1 Peter 1:3-12; 3:21). "Easter" came from the name of a 7th century Old English goddess (Eostre or Eastre, dawn goddess characterized as a "reluctant" bringer of light for which she is punished; also called the 'daughter of heaven'.) We are studying Paul's epistles with Sunday School curriculum from Answers in Genesis and continue Sunday evening 5:30 Bible study from LifeWay "Disciplespath: The Journey". The study is helping us become better disciples and have better fellowship in the Body. It is designed for a weekly lesson, but we take an average of 3 Sundays to finish a session. The current video series at 6:30 is "Moody Science Classics" with Dr. Irwin Moon. These films, from actual science classes in the 1950s, show that science supports the Bible, not opposes it. Calvary: The men of Calvary cooked up a great breakfast. Special speaker was Chris Smith, Volunteer Director, Show Me Youth Center. Pastor Jonathan is teaching a couples class every Tuesday for 12 weeks. Calvary Baptist was established 93 years ago, March 14, 1926. For all these year's saints have faithfully gathered to worship God here at Calvary. A Ladies Luncheon was held March 15th at noon. All the ladies brought their choice of foods and those who worked were our guest. A Women Bible Study was recommended to begin in April with Marie Satterwhite teaching on Tuesday mornings and Tina Walters teaching on Wednesday evenings. The name of the study "Secrets of the Vine". The title of the study is "Transformational Discipleship", how people really grow. Gospel Conversation Teams met, went out to visit people in our neighborhood. Forever Young had a carry-in meal in Fellowship Hall. This was a great time to fellowship with our Calvary family.

East Sedalia: In February we had a book study, "Share Jesus Without Fear" after morning services. Rev. David Faulkner was the leader for the study. Dr. Eddie Brown and Bro. Jeff Page supplied for us in February. We are participating in the Annie Armstrong Easter offering. The Friday night movie, "God is not Dead" was shown with refreshments of popcorn and drinks. We are anxiously waiting for Pastor Tim Smith and wife, Melody, to be on the field in April. Supply pastors in March have been Pastor Tim Smith, Dr. Eddie Brown, and Bro. Jeff Page.
