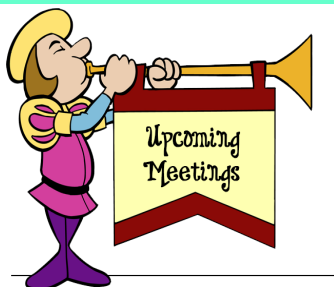
# Kid's Kamp Korner

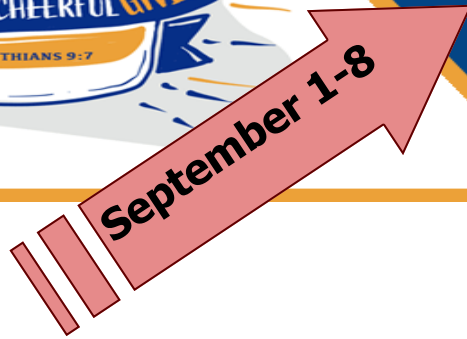

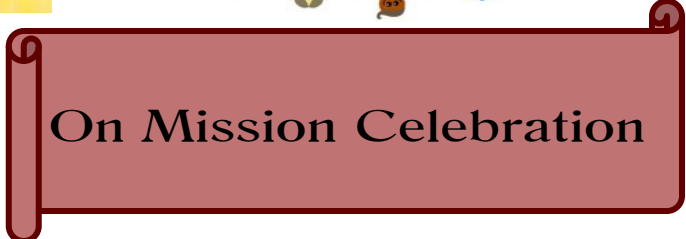

## “NEWS FROM OUR CHURCHES”

**Broadway:** To celebrate Summer in Sedalia, we scheduled the “Awesome Science Series” Sundays at 6:30 pm. 30-minute videos on National Parks, meteor craters, fossil beds, and petrified forests are from Answers in Genesis/MasterBooks. Videos created for kids by kids bring science to life with a Biblical Worldview at a level suitable for children, teens, and adults. We sent one girl to Kids Kamp. Sunday School curriculum from David C. Cook/Scripture Press is the book of Isaiah. We continue Sunday evening 5:30 Bible study from LifeWay “Disciplespath: The Journey.” Our new T-shirts are a great witnessing tool. So is our church sign which Ron changes periodically. Passersby tell us that messages cause thought-provoking discussions at home and work. Two persons that we know of joined the church because of the sign.

**Calvary:** Calvary had a great celebration on the fourth of July. Our choir celebrated with songs directed by Michael Sproles with Elaine at the organ and Judy at the piano. A cook out with Norm and Carroll at the grill and Pat and her crew put on a delicious meal attended by the church family and friends. Harmony Bible Study and singing met the first Monday of July. Kid’s Club and Calvary CREW met every Wednesday night during the summer. Calvary’s youth, eleven youth and four adults, traveled to Racine, Wisconsin to help another church. This great ministry was headed by Pastor Jonathan Wallenbeck. A new camera system was a proposal from our church council to help our church and was approved. This will make our videos more professional with better video and sound of our services. Meals on Wheels volunteers will deliver meals for one day in July and will deliver in August a full week. Thanks to all volunteers who help with the ministry. Our monthly visits to E.W. Thompson, Fair View and Rest Haven brings with it a message from Pastor Don and singing by our members with the residents. We had five professions of faith in July. Training to share your faith in three minutes or less at the Missouri State fair was held Sunday, July 28th at 5:00 pm. Pastor Don had fourteen in his new member’s class. PTL!!

**East Sedalia:** On June 30th we had a baptism and then a fellowship luncheon following the morning service. Donations were made to C.A.C.T.U.S. for school supplies. We continue to have Big Heroes for Kids and the Youth Group on Sunday evenings. Wednesday nights we have God’s Kids, and the youth group meets with a meal for ages 18 and younger. Adults meet also on Wednesday nights for Bible Study. Bible School was held July 21-25 from 6-8 p.m.

**Flat Creek:** We enjoyed a good week of VBS July 15-19 ending with a swim party at the Liberty pool on Friday evening and a commencement on Sunday morning for the church congregation followed by a lunch for all. We had a church wide food drive in conjunction with the mission project for VBS and took over 1600 cans of vegetables to Open Door.
