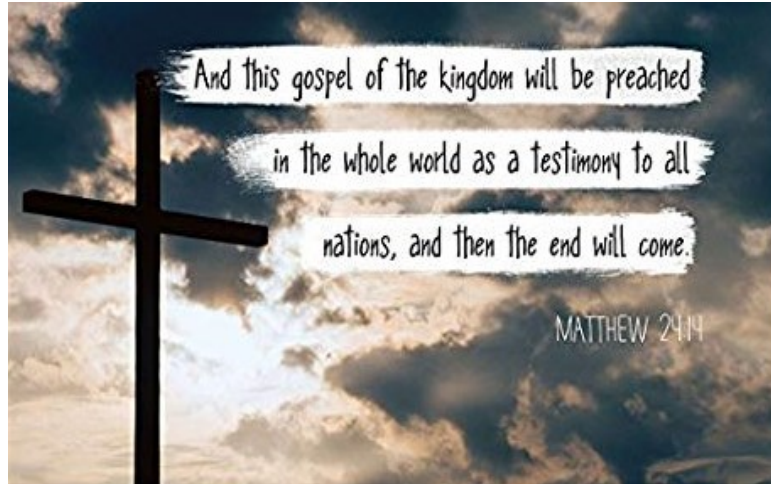

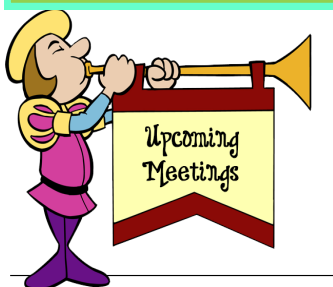
Kid's Kamp Korner

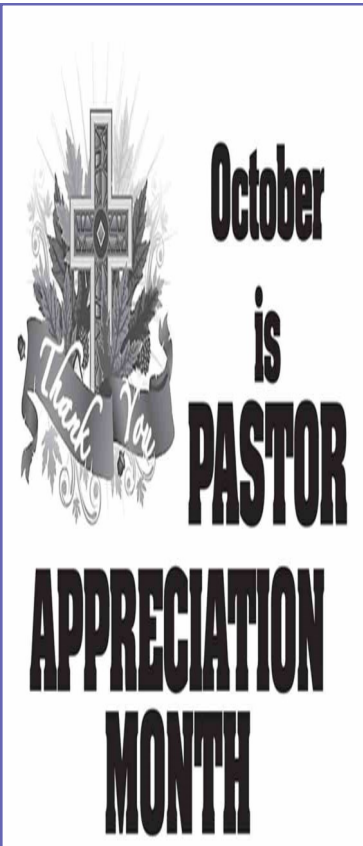
