

"NEWS FROM OUR CHURCHES"

<u>Bethany</u>: The saints began planning and preparing for three major summer outreaches: Vacation Bible School in June, Sagrada Scholarship Bible Camp in June and July, and serving at the Haiti Home of Hope orphanage in August. Our ladies met Tuesday evenings for a study from Elisabeth Elliot's book "Discipline - The Glad Surrender" and enjoyed a baked potato fellowship on the 24th. We served a meal at the Community Café on the 31st. We observed the Lord's Supper together the evening of Good Friday and met for breakfast and service on Resurrection Sunday. Pastor Bowen preached an evangelism series on Sunday mornings throughout March to challenge our unsaved attenders to turn to Christ. We started a series on the teachings of Islam on Sunday evenings.

Our pastor spoke and we visited with the residents. The men have a breakfast together the first Saturday of each month with a guest speaker. The Girl Scouts met with their leader, Jamie Poppinga. They honored Jim Lawson with an honorary membership into the Girl Scouts for his never ending giving of himself in providing materials and building to whatever needs to be done for the Girl Scouts.
