





The April 2017 Rodarama in Puyallup WA and the importance of check lists.

Recently my wife (Mel) and I took our 1936 International pickup to the car show in Puyallup WA. We thought it would be a fun trip and have friends in the area to visit with as well. After having trailered our pickup to Albany, on an open flatbed trailer, for the Winter Rod show there. We purchased an enclosed cargo/car hauler.

So we made plans and packed what we thought was needed. There was plenty of room in the trailer. I packed extra tools, for the just in case moments. I even put in a small gallon of gas. Since you're not supposed to have much in the tank for these shows. Extra clothes, etc.

Well we got there about 1:30 in the afternoon. I waited in line to drive my trailer into the auditorium to unload for the show. Finally it was my turn. I dropped the back ramp of the trailer and started removing the tie down straps to the pickup. Ok, got my spot located; now it's time to start it up and unload.

I reached into my pocket for the keys. Hmm better check the other pocket, better check my jacket pocket. No keys! NO KEYS!!! Ok, now what. Be creative, use a screwdriver to try and work the pins on the gas cap. Found out its pretty easy after all. Now I can add gas and re-start it and get it loaded. And we did. It loaded fine and we made our way home. Now I will get a spare key and put under the carpet or someplace, so this doesn't happen again. Guess I'll also make a check list before the next trip.




