

Member Profile: Ken and Vicki Champ

February 17th will mark the 46th wedding anniversary for Ken and Vicki Champ. They were high school sweethearts while attending Stayton High school, but most of their dating time was spent in the "shop" working on cars. They married after college and "Vietnam" (thank you Ken). Ken taught Vicki to drive in Ken's '53 Ford (mine was a '52 Vicki), and they both learned to ski behind Ken's 12 ft. Mahogany boat. Ken turned Vicki's first car ('65 Mustang) into a race car which she drag raced at Lion's Drag Strip while Ken was stationed in Long Beach, California. According to Vicki "Ken was always into fast cars and boats. He put a 454 big block Chevy with NOS into the family ski boat. He was crew chief for his cousin when they raced flat bottom boats and a "capsule" boat up and down the West Coast. Ken later became crew chief for a friend that had an AA gasser Studebaker that they raced in both Washington and Oregon".





Currently the Champs are having fun in Ken's 1931 Ford (purchased in 1994) and Vicki's '65 Mustang that she purchased in 2012. At the Winter Rod and Speed Show, they showed the 31, and Ken told me "... she did all the work!", but Vicki quickly remarked that she had only detailed it for the show, and that Ken had made all the modifications to the car. It is beautiful in any case. I could really see the love story behind these two sweet people. Ken just sat back in his chair and had a big smile on his face as folks admired the car.

Ken retired from Garman AT, and Vicki from the Greater Oregon Chapter of the Appraisal Institute, an association for real estate appraisers. They have been members of the Willamette Valley Street Rods for 10 years after moving to Salem. They also belong to an "unofficial car club" called "RoadKill Kruzers". Vicki says that membership in the club is "...contingent on how many seats are on Russ and Margie's "short bus"!

Vicki volunteers her time with Family Building Blocks, and says she was "compelled" to do so after attending an Auxiliary meeting.
