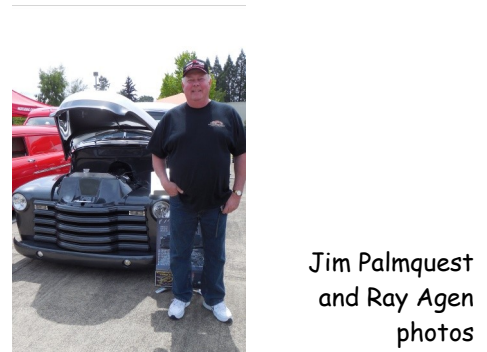


## Keizer Iris Festival Show & Shine presented by Keizer Elks

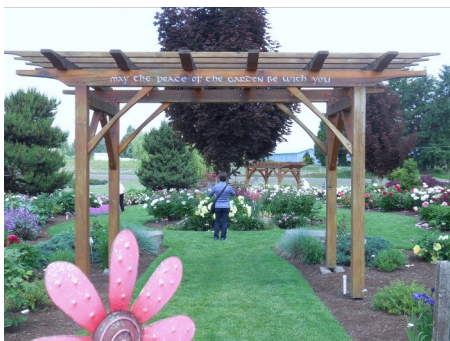
