

Supplies needed to begin: Tape Measure, pencil, and the Graph Paper printed from this guide.


Measure in inches only, mark all fixtures and utilities, electrical outlets and switches. Mark location and sizes of windows and doors and locations of existing appliances.

EXAMPLE FLOOR PLAN


