
## **Upcoming Events:**

- If you would like to sponsor someone, please be in prayer about sponsorship. If you aren't sure on how to sponsor someone, please visit our website, click on sponsorship and read up on who you should and should not sponsor and how to sponsor. Your pilgrim should have a home church that they attend regularly. Please be sure that is on the application. **Remember** Emmaus is not a fit for everyone. Allow the Lord to guide you on the decision of who to sponsor. When sending in a pilgrim appilcation please remember to include your \$30 deposit.
- If you wish to sponsor someone, please have the applications in **2 weeks prior** to the flights / walks. If it is after the 2 weeks, it will be at the discrection of the registrar.
