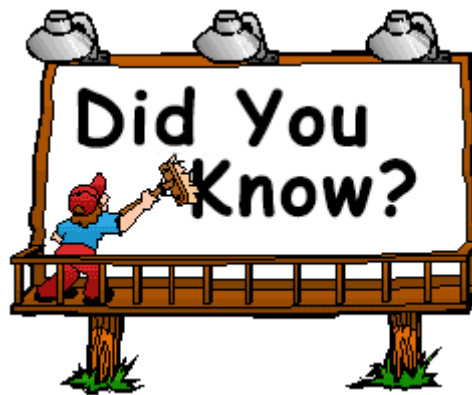
215 Wilson Street, Russell Springs KY 42642
