

- Please use the newest pilgrim application on line when sponsoring
- If you write a check PLEASE always write in the memo area who and what the check is for
- Fees are \$90.00 for a pilgrim or a worker. All fees must be paid by the time of the walk or flight. You cannot work if fees are not paid.
- During a Chrysalis flight there is a NO smoking rule. No smoking for workers or caterpillars even if they are age 18.
- If you are an adult working a Chrysalis flight don't forget your back ground check!
- We will no longer hold team fees past 1 yr. if you do not work and do not ask for your fee to be returned it will be absorbed into the general fund. *(Ex. If you paid in the spring and didn't work you would have till the next spring to ask to use that fee or have it refunded after that it will go into the Emmaus fund. If you intend to use the fee or want it returned please be sure you tell the treasurer or registrar.)*
