Below is a pie chart on how average team fees/ pilgrim fees are spent for a walk.

Supplies- \$7.92, Camp Mt. View- \$53.64, Food- \$23.67, Upper Room- \$3.06, Other- \$0.72, Profit- \$0.99. **Total- \$90.00**
