Dear Emmaus & Chrysalis Community,

We serve a Good, Good Father, one that loves us so much that he sent his son to die for each and every one of us. The book of Psalms has so many wonderful messages that it gives me encouragement when I read them. In Psalm 90:12 it says, “So teach us to number our days that we may gain a heart of wisdom.” Time is short and we need to use it well. Psalms 90 centers on the brevity of life and the stewardship of time. In meditating upon human frailty, Moses compares life to grass that withers. God Himself, on the other hand, is “from everlasting to everlasting.” Because of man’s sin, God has shortened his time at least twice. The early days of man averaged hundreds of years, Seth, the son of Adam for example, lived 912 years, Cainan, the grandson of Adam lived 910 years, and Methuselah, the son of Enoch lived 969 years. After the Flood, however, God shortened man’s time to 120 years. When we reach the time represented in Psalm 90, man’s years have been cut to 70 or 80 years. The final word recorded in James 4:13-16 is that man’s life is a vapor, with no guarantee as to the number of his years. Therefore, it is critical that people allow God to teach them to manage well the brief time they have on Earth. God honors the time we spend with him and the time we spend loving others. Let God be the main focus in your life and choose to spend more time each day with him.

We want to send a special thank you to Potter’s Place Church in Somerset for hosting our May gathering. We had a wonderful service and great attendance. Megan Richardson gave a beautiful 4<sup>th</sup> day message about how the Lord has used her since her Emmaus walk. We will continue to pray for God to use her in a mighty way.

Pray for the pilgrims, workers, and for the Holy Spirit to be with the Lay Directors as they choose who will give talks and work in the various places on the mountain. We want what the Lord wants and we need God’s guiding hand every step of the way. 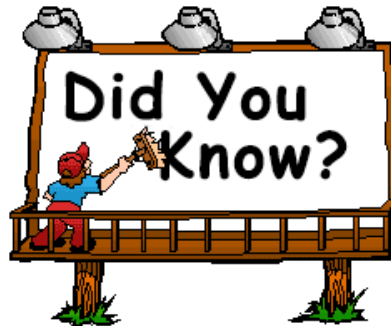
