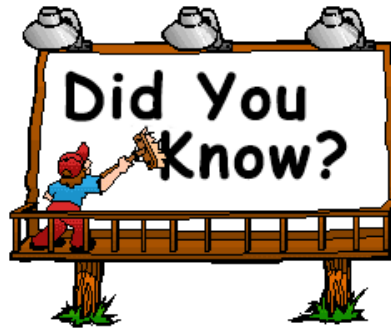
Candle Light on the Mountain Services begin at 8:00pm EST
