A **security check** (hand bag/belongings check) & registration will take place in the lobby by banquet room before students board the bus. Tickets need to be submitted & hands stamped. Students are to proceed directly to the buses located at east entrance of hotel.

Should any prohibited items be found, the student **will not be permitted to attend** Dry Grad. Parents/guardians will be contacted.

Transportation will be provided by bus from the Coast Hotel to The Metro leaving at approximately 11:30pm. Student and their guests **MUST** be transported to the Dry Grad party **by the bus provided**.

A secure monitored coat check area will be provided at The Metro for students to store belongings. Students' belongings are subject to search at any time. **LOCKERS** are available; **but students must bring their own locks**.

Return transportation to Brookswood Secondary School is provided again by bus leaving The Metro at **4:00- 4:15 am**.

Arrangements for pick up must be made for the Students and their guests at Brookswood Secondary School at **4:30 – 4:45 am (Friday June 27th).**

If students/guests MUST leave The Metro before 4:00 am the **parent/guardian** who signed the Consent and Release form **MUST pick up** the student or guest.
