Finished? Good, let's proceed.

Here is a song that points out repetitive sounds (and vibrations) that have a sense of urgency; sounds that are constantly around you and within you; the sounds that don't even have a sound experienced by the human ear. Sounds that in some part of you are incessant, either subconscious or conscious, that lead down a path of obsessive, yearning torment, whether you are aware of it or not.

What is this? For lack of a better phrase I like to call it the 'fate string'. Although soul mates and twin flames are highly aware of each other in the unearthly plane, when they return to an earthly existence they do not initially recognize each other (for the most part). There are numerous factors that could separate them- distance, cultures, age, etc. No matter how near or far these souls physically exist there is still a vibratory connection between you; the 'fate string'.

Think of a piano and its strings. Think of their lengths and their thicknesses. The further away the souls are, the longer the string. The longer the string is, the lower its vibration. You may or may not be aware of it. As you start your journey of life, choosing your personal pathways, your proximity to each other may grow closer. The closer the proximity, the shorter the string becomes. The shorter the string, the higher the resulting vibrations exist.
