Two-fold purpose:

- To equip the Body of Christ to serve one another and the whole world around u by the power of effective prayer ministry
- 2. To give instruction in the use of a particular prayer model that is:
 - a. accessible to the greatest number of people.
- b. usable and effective in the greatest number of settings

1. Step One: THE INTERVIEW

This answers the question: "Where does it hurt?"

- A. The interview is conducted at two planes
 - 1. Natural level (what's wrong, how can I help you?)
 - 2. <u>Supernatural</u> level (what is the Holy Spirit saying about this?)

1. Step One: THE INTERVIEW

- B. This is for information gathering (listen longer in a nonchurch setting)
- C. The interview is complete when:
 - 1. You have ascertained some of the natural and/or spiritual causes.
 - 2. God has inspired your with specific direction in prayer

1. Step One: THE INTERVIEW

- B. This is for information gathering (listen longer in a non-church setting)
 - 1. Natural level (what's wrong, how can I help you?)
 - 2. <u>Supernatural</u> level (what is the Holy Spirit saying about this?)

2. Step Two: THE DIAGNOSTIC DECISION

This answers the question: "What has caused this?"

A. It could be caused by <u>natural factors</u>

B. It could be caused by spiritual factors

3. Step Three: THE PRAYER SELECTION

This answers the question:

"What kind of prayer will I need to help this person?"

- A. Prayer directed toward God
- B. Prayer from God

4. Step Four: THE PRAYER ENGAGEMENT

This applies the power of God, while continually asking for the Holy Spirit's direction. This askes the question: "How are we doing?"

- A. Basics of Ministry Prayer
- B. Praying for Effect (the effect you are praying for is healing)
- C. The importance of dialogue

5. Step Five: POST-PRAYER DIRECTION

This answers the question: "What should I do or expect next?"

- A. Summarize the situation
- B. Avoid the following problems
- C. Refer them to their next action
