IV. THE REAL CHRISTIAN LIFE

Intimacy with Christ.

This is not just coming to a knowledge of Jesus, or understanding facts about Him. It is the foundation of what He has called us to "Intimacy with Him."

To draw near, to know Him, is where He reveals His love and affection for us. It happens with connection, time and dialogue with Him.

Dependency upon Christ.

Peter didn't practice walking on water, all he had was a willingness to be absolutely and completely dependent upon Jesus.

What God has called us to is absolute impossibility as broken people. Therefore, if you want to deal with your brokenness, don't look at your brokenness, but look to Jesus.
