Petitioned for the first public school in north Shelby County.

Married John Wesley Bledsoe Sanderlin Stewart mid 1850.

John Wesley Stewart, Jr.

First "free-born" child of John and Mary.
June 26, 1867.

Lorenzo Stewart

Second "free-born" son born to John and Mary in 1881.

Carrie Ethel Stewart

"Free-born" daughter of John and Mary born in 1879.

Harriet Stewart

Daughter of John and Mary - one of the first teachers in the first public school in north Shelby County.

Amanda Stewart

Daughter of John and Mary - one of the first teachers in the first public school in north Shelby County.

Ida Stewart

Daughter of John and Mary - one of the first teachers in the first public school in north Shelby County.

Dr. Fred J. Stewart

Born in slavery, became the first black doctor in north Shelby County
