



# Krotz Springs Sportsmen's Heritage Festival Queen's Activities Contract

**Terms, Conditions, & Guidelines**

- I. The Queen is required to attend a minimum of ten (10) festivals/pageants. Listed are six (6) festivals you are required by the Association to attend. The additional four (4) are of your choice.
  - Cracklin Festival Pageant, Port Barre, LA
  - Étouffée Pageant, Arnaudville, LA
  - Gueydan Duck Festival, Gueydan, LA
  - Bunkie Corn Festival, Bunkie, LA
  - Breaux Bridge Crawfish Festival, Breaux Bridge, LA
  - \*\*Louisiana Shrimp and Petroleum Festival, Morgan City, LA (if invited) \*\*
- II. The Queen is required to attend all Cultural Events in the Town of Krotz Springs as a representative of the Krotz Springs Sportsmen's Heritage Festival. Including, but not limited to:
  - Krotz Springs Memorial Day Program Monday of Memorial Day Weekend in Nall Park
  - Krotz Springs Independence Day Celebration "Fireworks on the River"
  - Krotz Springs Senior Citizen's Fall Gumbo & Spring Bar-B-Que
  - Krotz Springs Elementary Veteran's Day Program
  - Krotz Springs Christmas Parade & Lighting of Christmas Tree

\*\*You may be called upon for other town activities not listed above\*\*
- III. The Queen is required to call or e-mail her Pageant Director on a monthly basis to be informed of additional activities/events. The Queen is also required to inform the Pageant Director of all activities she has attended during the month.

- IV. The Queen is encouraged to attend the KS Sportsmen's Heritage Festival Meetings held monthly. The Queen is also encouraged to assist with compiling the Festival Scrapbook to be submitted for 2020 LAFF Competition.
- V. The Queen is required to attend the KS Sportsmen's Heritage Festival held Thursday through Saturday, May 24<sup>th</sup> and 25<sup>th</sup>, 2019 and May 21<sup>st</sup>, 22<sup>nd</sup>, and 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020 (year of reign).
- VI. The Queen is required to conduct herself in a respectable, dignified, and courteous manner during the year in which she is representing the KS Sportsmen's Heritage Festival. **Please be aware that if any of the following rules are broken, the proper actions will be taken immediately!**
  - No drinking alcoholic beverages
  - No smoking
  - No public display of affection
  - No use of illegal drugs
  - No rude or unlawful conduct
- VII. The Queen agrees to participate in the Queen of Queens Competition to be held February 2020 in Baton Rouge at the La Fairs and Festivals Association Convention. The festival Provides Registration fees and a Hotel Room for the contestant and her chaperone (includes contestant's meals). The Contestant is responsible for all other expenses associated with the Pageant.
