#### How to Register:

- Complete entire registration packet (attached). Please complete all required signatures and questions in ink.
- The program registration fee is \$600. Payments can be made by check, credit card, or money order. Checks should be made out to "Anchorage Youth Court." Credit card payments can be made in person at the Anchorage Youth Court office (address below) or by phone to 274-5986.
- Registration is on a first come, first served basis. There is a limit of 40 students for the program.
- Registration runs from April 10<sup>th</sup> to June 22<sup>nd</sup>.

- **4.** Arrivals and Departures: The pickup and drop off area of the program is at the main entrance of the school. Program monitors will be at the school from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. each day. School doors will open at 8:00 a.m. and close promptly at 5:00 p.m.
- **5. Transportation:** The program will provide transportation to and from the program for participants who need it. Transportation will be either through busing students directly or providing public bus passes and guidance on routes and timetables.
- 6. High School Credit: Participants will be eligible to receive .5 credits toward high school graduation through the Credit by Choice program. Students who miss 3 days (or 21 hours) or more will not receive high school credit.
- 7. Personal Belongings: Personal belongings are the participant's responsibility. The program will not be responsible for lost or stolen items. Personal belongings from home are not needed and are discouraged. Guns, knives, and other such items are not allowed.
- 8. Meals: The camp fee includes a lunch. There will be no refunds or options on the lunch menu. The camp plans to feed students similarly to standard school lunches. Students may bring a bag lunch if these meals present an issue.
- **9.** Field Trips: There will field trips to various law-related organizations and government offices, including, but not limited to the Alaska Court System, the Anchorage Federal Courthouse, the Alaska State Crime Lab, and the Anchorage Police Department.
- **10. Cancellation Policy**: Full refunds are available up to June 22<sup>nd</sup>. A 50% refund is available up to July 3<sup>rd</sup>. No refunds are available for cancellations after July 3<sup>rd</sup>.
