# **FINA Senior Rules**

#### Men and Women 1 meter and 3 meter Springboard (No age restriction)

- The Women's springboard competitions shall comprise five (5) dives from five (5) different groups without limit of degree of difficulty.
- The Men's springboard competitions shall comprise six (6) dives from five (5) different groups without limit of degree of difficulty.

#### Men and Women Platform (No age restriction)

- The Women's platform competitions shall comprise five (5) dives from five (5) different groups without limit of degree of difficulty. Only dives from the 10 meter platform may be performed.
- The Men's platform competitions shall comprise six (6) dives from six (6) different groups without limit of degree of difficulty. Only dives from the 10 meter platform may be performed.

# FINA Junior (Age Group) Rules

Divers may compete in age groups above their FINA age.

#### Group A

- Girls' Springboard 1 meter and 3 meter. This competition shall comprise nine (9) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.5 for 3 meter events and 9.0 for 1 meter events, and four (4) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.
- Girls' Platform 5 meter 7.5 meter 10 meter. This competition shall comprise eight (8) different dives; four (4) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 7.6, and four (4) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group. At least five (5) different groups must be used.
- Boys' Springboard 1 meter and 3 meter. This competition shall comprise ten (10) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.5 for 3 meter events and 9.0 for 1 meter events, and five (5) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.
- Boys' Platform 5 meter 7.5 meter 10 meter. This competition shall comprise nine (9) different dives; four (4) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 7.6, and five (5) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group. All six (6) groups must be used.

#### Group B

- Girls' Springboard 1 meter and 3 meter. This competition shall comprise eight (8) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.5 for 3 meter events and 9.0 for 1 meter events, and three (3) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.
- Girls' Platform 5 meter 7.5 meter 10 meter. This competition shall comprise seven (7) different dives; four (4) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 7.6, and three (3) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group. At least five (5) different groups must be used.
- Boys' Springboard 1 meter and 3 meter. This competition shall comprise nine (9) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.5 for 3 meter events and 9.0 for 1 meter events, and four (4) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.
- Boys' Platform 5 meter 7.5 meter 10 meter. This competition shall comprise eight (8) different dives; four (4) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 7.6, and four (4) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group. All least five (5) different groups must be used.

#### Group C

- Girls' Springboard 1 meter and 3 meter. This competition shall comprise seven (7) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.5 for 3 meter events and 9.0 for 1 meter events, and two (2) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.
- Girls' Platform 5 meter or 7.5 meter. This competition shall comprise six (6) different dives; four (4) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 7.6, and two (2) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.
- Boys' Springboard 1 meter and 3 meter. This competition shall comprise eight (8) different dives; five (5) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 9.5 for 3 meter events and 9.0 for 1 meter events, and three (3) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.
- Boys' Platform 5 meter or 7.5 meter. This competition shall comprise seven (7) different dives; four (4) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 7.6, and three (3) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.

#### Group D

Girls' and Boys' Springboard – 1 meter and 3 meter & Platform – 5 meter only. This competition shall comprise five (5) different dives; three (3) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 5.4 and two (2) dives without limit of degree of difficulty, each dive selected from a different group.

#### Group E

Girls' and Boys' Springboard – 1 meter and 3 meter & Platform – 5 meter only. This competition shall comprise four (4) different dives; three (3) dives each selected from a different group, the total degree of difficulty shall not exceed 5.4 and one (1) dive without limit of degree of difficulty.

# **Synchro Elite Rules**

Divers may compete with different partners and mixed gender, up to three synchro teams. Divers must compete in their age group.

#### Synchro Elite 13&Under 3M Springboard (6 dives)

4 voluntary dives from different groups; each voluntary with a DD of 2.0 2 optional dives from different group

Synchro Elite 13&Under 5M Platform (5 dives on 5M only from 4 different groups) 3 voluntary dives from different groups; each voluntary with a DD of 2.0 2 optional dives from different group

### Synchro Elite 14&Up 3M Springboard & Platform 5M, 7M or 10M (6 dives from 5 different groups)

3 voluntary dives from different groups; each voluntary with a DD of 2.0 3 optional dives from different group

# **Bank of Dives for Intermediate & Future Champions Rules**

**Skills:** 100 A, B, C – 1.0 degree of difficulty

- 200 A,B,C 1.0 degree of difficulty
- 001 A,B,C 1.2 degree of difficulty
  - 002 A,B,C 1.3 degree of difficulty

Dives: Any dive with true degree of difficulty from **<u>FINA Table of Degrees of Difficulty</u>** 

# **Intermediate Rules**

Girls and Boys 11&Under, 12&Up (Divers must compete in their age group)

# 1M and 3M Springboard (5 Dives from the Bank of Dives)

- Maximum two (2) skills may be performed (skills are not required).
- May repeat dives in different position
- Any approach is allowed (standing, bouncing, one or multiple step hurdle)

# Platform 1M, 3M, 5M, 7.5M and 10M (5 Dives from the Bank of Dives)

- Maximum two (2) skills, skills are not required.
- May repeat dives from different platform height
- May repeat dives in different position from the same platform height
- Any approach is allowed (standing, one or multiple step approach)
- 1M platform is the same degree of difficulty as 1M springboard
- 3M platform is the same degree of difficulty as 3M springboard

# **Future Champions Individual Rules**

Girls and Boys 7&Under, 8-9, 10-11, 12&Up (Divers must compete in their age group)

# 1M and 3M Springboard (5 Dives from the Bank of Dives)

- Minimum three (3) skills are required, may do all skill for the five (5 dives)
- Maximum Degree of Difficulty is 1.8 on dives.
- May repeat dives in different position
- Any approach is allowed (standing, bouncing, one or multiple step hurdle)

# Platform 1M, 3M, 5M, 7.5M and 10M (5 Dives from the Bank of Dives)

- Minimum three (3) skills are required, may do all skill for the five (5 dives)
- Maximum Degree of Difficulty is 1.8 on dives.
- May repeat dives from different platform height
- May repeat dives in different position from the same platform height
- Any approach is allowed (standing, one or multiple step approach)
- 1M platform is the same degree of difficulty as 1M springboard
- 3M platform is the same degree of difficulty as 3M springboard

# **Future Champions Synchro Rules**

Divers may compete with different partners and mixed gender, up to three synchro teams. No age restriction.

### 1M and 3M Springboard (5 Dives from the Bank of Dives)

- Minimum three (3) skills are required, may do all skill for the five (5 dives)
- Maximum Degree of Difficulty is 1.8 on dives.
- May repeat dives in different position
- Any approach is allowed (standing, bouncing, one or multiple step hurdle)
