

Place Value Game

Materials

A deck of cards

At least one opponent



Procedure

1. Remove all tens and face cards from the deck (Jokers, Jacks, Queens and Kings)
2. Select a dealer
3. The dealer then asks each player, how many cards they would like and deals the amount of cards they selected to each player face down.

Ex. 3 digit number (3 cards)

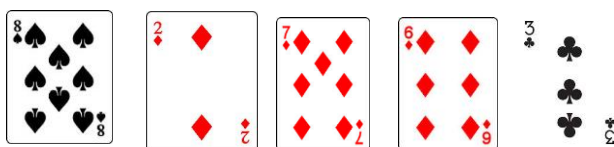
4 digit number (4 cards)

5 digit number (5 cards)

6 digit number (6 cards)

4. Next, the dealer deals himself/herself a set of cards too.
5. The dealer asks his/her opponent to flip over each card.

Ex.



6. The opponent then **reads** aloud the number that the cards have created.
Ex. 82 763 (eighty-two thousand one hundred sixty-three)
7. If the opponent is correct, he/she earns a point, however, if the player is incorrect the dealer can, then, steal the point by saying the number correctly. If no one can correctly say the number no points are earned.
8. This is done for each player of the game.
9. Once the round is completed, the cards that have been used are placed in the centre of the game and a new dealer is selected for the next round.
10. Continue playing each round as stated above. When all cards have been used by the dealer, collect and shuffle cards from the centre of the game in order to continue playing.
