Four Reasons Why Jesus Will Come Back

Let's look at four central reasons the Scripture gives as to why Christ is going to return. We find these reasons in two Scripture references.

The first reference is 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10, where it says God will,

"give you who are troubled rest with us when the Lord Jesus is revealed from heaven with His mighty angels, in flaming fire taking vengeance on those who do not know God, and on those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus Christ. These shall be punished with everlasting destruction from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power, when He comes, in that Day, to be glorified in His saints and to be admired among all those who believe."

Here it says Jesus is going to return to give troubled believers rest, and be glorified and admired by them.

It also says here that Jesus is going to return to take vengeance on those who reject God and the gospel.

The other Scripture reference we will look at is 1 Corinthians 15:22-25, which reads:

"For as in Adam all die, even so in Christ all shall be made alive. But each one in his own order: Christ the firstfruits, afterward those who are Christ's at His coming. Then comes the end, when He delivers the kingdom to God the Father, when He puts an end to all rule and all authority and power. For He must reign till He has put all enemies under His feet."

Here, we are told that Jesus is going to return to raise to life all those who have died who belong to Him.

In addition, we are told that Jesus is going to return to reign so that all rule and authority are His, and His enemies are defeated.

Putting together what we have found, we see the following four reasons why Jesus will return:

- To raise to life all those who have died who belong to Him.
- To give troubled believers rest, and be glorified and admired by them.
- To take vengeance on those who reject God and the gospel.
- To reign so that all rule and authority are His, and His enemies are defeated.

From the way the apostle Paul wrote about these things, they will all happen in quick succession at the return of Jesus. And according to Jesus Himself in Matthew 24:21-30, He will return "immediately after" a short period of great tribulation.
