RANGE FIRING SCHEDULE FOR THE PERIOD OF April 21st – 27th

GRAYLING, Mich. – the training ramps back up for the weekend out here at Camp Grayling Joint Maneuver Training center, residents in and around our Small Arms Ranges located north of Howe Road, east of the gas pipeline, south of Portage Creek and west of Lake Margrethe will hear an increase of small arms firing Friday April 21st through Thursday, April 27th.

A little further north at Camp Grayling's Multi-Purpose Range Complex also known as the Range 30 complex, located north of North Down River Road, east of Jones Lake Road, south of County Road 612 and west of Bald Hill Truck Trail residents may hear some machine gun firing and small arms firing beginning Friday April 21st through Thursday, April 27th. During that timeframe all roads and trails west of Wakely Bridge road, to include; Bucks East-West Truck Trail from Jones Lake Road to Wakeley Bridge Road, Ketchum truck Trail from Bucks East-West to North Down River Road, and Stephen Bridge Road from County Road 612 to North Down River Road will be closed. This is our large range fan danger zone and will be active during this time. Please respect all closed gates and do not enter these areas for your safety.

Located at Camp Grayling's Range 40 Complex, also known as the Air to Ground range which is located north of County Road 612, east of Guthrie Lake, south of Old State Road 618 and west of County Road F97 (Twin Bridge Road) residents may hear and see low flying A-10 Thunderbolt and F-16 aircraft on Friday, April 21st, and resuming on Tuesday, April 25th through Thursday, April 27th.

The construction crews are continuing to work on our Main Access gate, however we are still expecting it to still be closed until June 2017. All traffic will use the South Access Gate off of Military Road.
