RANGE FIRING SCHEDULE FOR THE PERIOD OF August 13th – 19th, 2017

GRAYLING, Mich. – Northern Strike 2017 is complete! Another successful year and the Michigan National Guard and Camp Grayling would like to thank you, the residents for this success. We do have some training scheduled, however it is not as much as we have had here the last few weeks! With that, residents in and around our Small Arms Ranges located north of Howe Road, east of the gas pipeline, south of Portage Creek and west of Lake Margrethe may hear small arms firing and explosions during the timeframe of August 17th – 19th.

It will be a lot more quieter a little further north at Camp Grayling's Multi-Purpose Range Complex also known as the Range 30 complex, located north of North Down River Road, east of Jones Lake Road, south of County Road 612 and west of Bald Hill Truck Trail. All roads and trails west of Wakeley Bridge road, to include; Bucks East-West Truck Trail from Jones Lake Road to Wakeley Bridge Road, Ketchum truck Trail from Bucks East-West to North Down River Road, and Stephen Bridge Road from County Road 612 to North Down River Road will be open to civilian traffic August 13th – 16th. Those roads will be closed to civilian traffic August 17th- 20th. This is our large range fan danger zone and will be active during this timeframe. Please respect all closed gates and do not enter these areas for your safety.

Camp Grayling's Range 40 Complex, also known as the Air to Ground range, which is located north of County Road 612, east of Guthrie Lake, south of Old State Road 618 and west of County Road F97 (Twin Bridge Road) residents in the area may see or hear low flying fixed wing aircraft and explosions within the impact area of Range 40, August 15th and 16th.
