out, so he made accusations based on what he saw Job do regularly. He watched Job purifying his children, rising up early in the morning to offer burnt offerings for all of them. Job did this because he thought his kids had sinned and cursed God in their hearts. Satan is also watching and studying us, trying to get some dirt on us but whatever accusations he comes up with, **let it not be so!!!** (Job 1:11, John 8:44)

Job had it going on, he was blessed, naturally and spiritually. The bible says Job was the greatest man among all the people in the east. We can see why Satan thought he had Job figured out because most people with his status probably would have e been exactly as he said. Satan didn't believe what God said about Job because he was going by Job's actions, but the bible says, "Man



looks at the outside but God looks at the heart." [1 Samuel 16:7] Loving and serving God is personal, it's a heart issue and no one knows our heart like the Father. Even though God had blessed Job and his family, his children did not have the same heart towards God. Our actions may not always be righteous but our hearts should always be pure towards God and the things of God. tude. People are involuntarily serving the enemy, yet enjoying it. But the bible did tell us that sin is good for a season. [Hebrews 11:24-26] People are blinded and drawn away to sin by their own lust and enticed. [James 1:14] This is what I meant when I said people enjoy being in bondage. Job's children were in a blessed place but deception and probably some rebellion was also present. Isn't it funny how the enemy tries to make our blessed place look like a cursed place? All the time his agenda is to get us out of the will of God. We have all been there, especially when we were in the world doing our own thing and having a good time, so we thought. We didn't know we were involuntarily serving and promoting Satan's agenda.

Satan has placed all sorts of influences, snares and traps around us. For us to fall into predicaments that we later regret. The lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life will lead us into places of involuntary servi-

tude. [1 John 2:16] Remember sin will always take us further

than we want to go, cost us more than we want to pay, and keep us longer than we want to stay. Have you ever found yourself doing something not on your agenda for that day, that's no coincidence? Something or someone persuaded you to do it. Remember the enemy studies us, just like he did Job. And he knows what and who to put in our paths to throw us off course. We think we get up every morning and make decisions of what we want to do; Satan is always on duty, waiting for the right moment to interrupt up our day. That is why acknowledging and seeking God daily is so vital. Have you ever seen a commercial before walking out the door that seduced you to do something that was not on the agenda? Although God was dealing with you about exercising and eating healthier, we swung into the IHOP parking lot because of the commercial- instead of obeying God's voice. SAY IT AIN'T SO!!! Satan is subtle, he doesn't overwhelm us with sin because he would get shut down. He uses one

bait at a time until we're caught, hooked, line and sinker. And if God does not help us, we will find ourselves out of control. Which voice will we obey, God or our belly? Deuteronomy.30:19 says, "I have set before you, life and death..... choose life" I know we don't think it's that serious but the next decision we make can be a life or death decision. Adam and Eve didn't think the forbidden fruit would cause the damage it did; and we are still suffering today.

The word bondage makes us think about a person in chains and in a dark place. Slave is not a word many want to be associated with but the bible says we are slaves in Christ. [Romans 6:18] It seems like we are free agents, running the show but we're not. We are like puppets on a string and whoever we yield our members to is our master. In the right state of mind, nobody enjoys being in bondage outside of Christ. And that is the battlefield, our mental state of mind. The GO-SPEL is a spell, or bondage I don't mind being controlled by. Many have ruined their lives and the lives of others think-



dead men tales? often wondered in light of the testimony that is being given by the church. But I am quick to be reminded of the words of Christ, "except a corn of wheat fall into the ground and die, it abideth alone (single seed), but if it dies it bringeth forth much fruit". [John 12:24] We who are dead in Christ, in light of faith, appear to tell tales in representing the facts concerning the kingdom of God. For example, we speak of healings we don't possess, money that has not been deposited into our accounts and a Holiness that is not always resident in our everyday lives. But when you look at what Jesus said about the power of a seed, it only

reaches the fullness of its potential when it is resurrected. The church may appear powerless, dormant, and sometimes weak, but when it arises it shall be everything and more than this world could ever think, dream, or imagine. [1 Corinthians 2:9]

As we celebrate this time of the Resurrection of Christ, God is also releasing a new standard or new dimension in the lives of the believer. Not just against sin, but against spirits of religion and tradition and even against our bad habits. I believe God wants to bring forth his new creation. Everything that is in you may not have necessarily come out of you. Understand it is the Glory of God that hides a thing, but in this hour the

King in you will discover these divine hidden treasures. God is bringing out the essence of what He intended when He first designated his people as a Holy Nation. Please don't be dismayed by what some denominations have done to the Holiness Banners. As some have termed us as rock gut Pentecostal, Spirit-filled. We were not known for having the greatest of character, though we were Holiness by tradition. The spotlight has somehow magnified those who lacked in strength of performance in demonstrating the discipline we upheld in the faith. Thus, the world developed a very poor image of the Spiritfilled church. We have gained a reputation of being very loud, but also became known

for not paying our bills. We knew how to have good church, but we are debased for having far too many affairs. This profile has hurt the "Holiness," Spirit-filled church in the marketplace. You see when you are numbered with the transgressors it becomes a challenge to any faith. When you cannot completely deny the labels, any act of immortality is painted with the same brush. We are all then numbered and linked together, despite the imperfections of some who did travel under the banner of Holiness. These misrepresentations do not go away with God's original designation for His people, "Be ye Holy, for I am Holy." [Leviticus 11:44] God desires and will have a Holy Nation of people who are set apart from the worldly living by God's standards not the world's. Not perfect, but distinct from the world. The text lets us know that is already our position in Christ. I prefer to be called a just man, than a gifted man. There are those in the world who label us as charismatic, but sarcastically are trying to cast a negative image on the believer. The enemy wants people to disassociate themselves with those who have embraced the ministry of the Holy Spirit. In the 80's out of the top five Pentecostal churches in America, today only one out of the five exists. Why? Because of some type of immortality in the leadership, based on this startling observation it is no wonder the world looks at the church in a negative way.

Ezekiel 3:15 says, "I sat where they sat."

The church was put in the world to counter the culture of the time. We are anointed to relate to every sect of society, the teens, the rich, the poor, and the divorced. We have to be able to relate to their struggle in order to be effective. However, in our challenge to relate, we still must maintain our standard of holiness. We are not called to embrace the culture, but to counter the culture. The church was put here on the earth to be salt and light. [Matthew 5:13-16] Salt has to be different from what it is placed into that it may change the flavor of the situation. You do not salt something for it to taste the same, you salt

something for it to taste different. God sprinkled Crossroads For Life Ministries in Douglas County Georgia to change the flavor of the area. We as believers have been put here on earth to counter the culture of the darkness. To just embrace it and say we are powerless to do anything about it is defeating the mission of God. We are not a powerless people who have to consent to do what the world is doing. We are the church, the body of Christ, the most powerful organism in the world today. [Matthew 16:18] When we pray we pull rank on the enemies of God. Remember the characteristics of this new nation of God's chosen, they are peculiar, royal and they are Holy. That's right Holy!!!

One good thing about the Pentecostal Church is they live what they believe; they were never ashamed to live out their conviction. The problem was the mind set, we believed we were saved by grace and we thought we kept that salvation by living right. The moment you believe your salvation is dependent upon anything you do or do not do, you have just robbed God of his glory. The Bible says "salvation is the gift of

God." [Ephesians 2:8-9] By grace you were saved and by grace you are going to stay saved. You can never do anything to make God love you more than he already loves you or any less. His love and grace are perfect forevermore. God is going to get all the glory for our obtaining and sustaining our salvation. Now expressing our salvation is another issue, we define faith

by the way we conduct our lives as believers.

The tree that Adam and Eve ate of was the knowledge of good and evil. What many people do not recognize is the good was just as destructive as the evil. Being good can foster a sense of spiritual pride making some Christians believe, because I am good enough I worked my way back into God's grace. Con-

versely, if I do something evil enough I can work my way out. The scripture already reminds us that we are not strong enough to boast of our own good, but the work of Christ that made us righteous, holy and redeemed. [1 Corinthians 1:29-30] One of the problems with the early church was not the Gentiles being converted, but how these Gentiles would receive

salvation without keeping all the laws. This is still the struggle with many sects of the church. What we need to understand is when an unbeliever accepts Christ, they can be on the same level playing field as the saints. Please remember dear Christians, if it had not been for the Lord on your side, where would any of us be?

Now that we understand the Grace standard, that it was God's grace that bought our liberty. We must also be aware that the enemy will seduce us, if possible, to use our grace as an occasion to sin. God's grace was never intended to give us wiggle room to sin. Grace really raises the bar for the believer. The word Holy in the Christian relationship bears the connotation as to be transcendent, reverent, set apart or a "cut above". When something is Holy, it is always a cut above. God is Holy, a cut above; likewise we should also be Holy, a cut above. Not to live like the world, but a cut above. Now that God has given us his Holy Spirit, we have a greater capacity to live Holy.

We no longer have to tolerate sin in any form in our lives, but have the power to destroy its hold and live a cut above. We must recognize sin's objective is to lead us away from the plan of God to bring us down to the destruction of the enemy. James said, "sin's ultimate goal death." [James 1:15] Satan wants to be lord and he accomplishes this through the activity of sin in our lives. We must understand whatever you obey is your master. [Romans 6:16] Thus, if we are going to maintain the salvation we obtained from Christ Jesus, we must pursue His Holy plan of living. The writer of Hebrews says to pursue Holiness, without such no man will see the Lord God. [Hebrews 12:14] We abstain from evil not to get or be saved, no, but to stand as one who has been approved before the Lord. God leaves this matter of the flesh and its control over to the individual. Paul, the writer of over half of the New Testament, says I discipline my body and bring it into subjection, lest when I have preached to others I myself should become disqualified. [1 Corinthians 9:27] If sin of the flesh could disqualify Paul from receiving his reward, the one whose words we preach, what about us?

Thank God for his Grace, but let's not frustrate that grace, by allowing sin to reign in our lives. Because of what Grace has accomplished, what shall I render under God for all His benefits? Striving to live a Holy life, a life based on God's standards should be the response to grace. Not going back to the thing you were freed from is a testimony of the power of God operating in our lives.



Summary

Fellowship with family - Father [v3] = Fellowship with Adam
