



Face Your Giant [1 Samuel 17]]

AS people we all face different types giants in our lives- giant tasks, people, or situations. Your giant may not be my giant but we all have giants. In 1 Samuel 17, David shows us that it is not about the size of the person, nor about the size of the giant (situation), but it's all about our faith, trust and confidence in Jehovah God, our Giant and Champion .

In this chapter King Saul, the men of Israel and the armies of the Philistines were in battle. Their champion, Goliath, which is said to have been about nine feet tall, was taunting, teasing and mocking the armies of the living God; challenging them [vs.8] to choose a man for themselves to come down and fight with him. The deal was this- to whomever won the fight, the Philistines would become their servants or vice versa. Now Saul was not a short man, if we read 1 Samuel 10:23 it tells us that Saul was taller than all of the people, so there must have been something about Goliath that intimidated him, the scripture says he was dismayed and greatly afraid of Goliath. [1 Sam.17:11] As people of God, we are commanded to walk by faith and not by sight. Do not be afraid of their faces, the bible warns, [Deuteronomy 1:17] believe it or not Saul is not the only one who is guilty of being intimidated by size, appearance and words.

Think about this giant what some call the Big C- cancer or even HIV; at the mention of these words fear rises in the hearts of many, not because we have had a firsthand experience with these diseases but because of what we have heard about them. Not considering that there are many who have and still are living with these diseases but our minds somehow will gravitate to the worst case scenarios. We focus on what man says, there is no cure, but what did God say? He is still King of Kings and Lord of Lords. The last I heard, his words have the final authority. Scripture tells us we have a name that is higher than



any other name and at the name of **JESUS** every knee will bow and every tongue will confess that Jesus is Lord. [Romans 14:11] We do not have to fear when we stay close to Jesus. He is Jehovah Elyon, the Most High God.

Notice in vs.16, Goliath came forth every morning and evening for forty days and stood and repeatedly said the same thing over and over, waiting for someone to come fight him. Goliath's appearance and words put fear in the armies of God. and they never said anything back. The giants in our lives seek to silence us also, my Pastor taught this message: "You Don't Have the Right to Remain Silent" Proverbs 18:21 says "life and death is in the power of the tongue." If we are going to live and have victory over the giants in our lives, the bible says "let the redeemed of the Lord say so," we have to talk back to our giants. As

children of God, we all have been redeemed from the giants of the curses of the law; poverty, sickness, and spiritual death, so we must exercise our rights through the words of our mouths. [Galatians 3:13]

One early morning David was sent by his father to take food to his brothers who were fighting and he overheard Goliath challenging God's people. And he asked "who is this uncircumcised Philistine that he should taunt the armies of the living God." (vs.26) Goliath was making sarcastic remarks and mocking the people of God, he was talking junk to God's people and David didn't like it. David was not intimidated by Goliath's size nor his threats and he accepted the challenge to fight Goliath. King Saul tells David that he is not able to go against Goliath because he is a youth but David did not allow Saul's lack of confidence in him to discourage him. David's outward appearance led King Saul to doubt his ability to fight against Goliath and win.

The bible ask a question "does the unbelief of others make the word of God of no effect?" [Romans 3:3] Because of David's statue. King Saul clothed him with his armor (vs.38) which was the same type of armor that Goliath was fighting with. God does not want us to be conformed to the worlds way of doing things- even warfare, we know that the weapons of our warfare are not carnal but are mighty through God. [2 Corinthians 10:4] David knew he could not win against Goliath with Saul's armor, he was not familiar with it, so he took it off. Instead David begin to tell King Saul about the goodness of God, how he went after, struck down and killed the lion and the bear after they took a lamb from the flock he was tending for his father. David had faith in God, the same way God helped and delivered him from the paws of the lion and the bear, he knew that God would also help and deliver him from Goliath.

Each of the battles in our lives are necessary, small and great, every victory with God makes us more prepared for the next one just as they did for David.

Since no one else spoke up while Goliath was taunting God's people, David said, "you come to me with natural weapons but I come to you in the name of the Lord of hosts. [vs.45] The Lord does not deliver by sword or spear." [vs.47] David took his stick and five smooth

stones from the brook and his sling and he approached Goliath, the Philistine, But when he saw David approaching him he began to disdain David because he was a young boy. [vs.42] In the natural we know that a sling and stones do not compare to the armor that Goliath had but David had something greater on his side, he had the hand of God on his life and in his favor. He had help from Heaven! All God needs is someone to believe!!!

Someone may be thinking you are too small for your giant (situation) but don't let that stop you from going after your Goliath, remember if God be for you, who be against vou? can [Romans 8:31] Our fear of God and our love for God should outweigh the fear of any giant in our lives. David defeated the lion, the bear and Goliath with the same weapon, one not made by mans hands but by the confidence, trust and faith in his God. There is a song that says "giants do die, the bigger they are, the harder they fall." Let's face our giants and make them fall HARD, in Jesus name.



oday, we are living in the midst of an ever changing society. We are pressed upon with different opportunities, different opinions. and different expressions. We are living in a technological age. This is a generation that is forever looking for away to obtain information. Therefore. we are bombarded with continual change. This presents a challenge to the preacher of the gospel who is showing a way that does not change. It should be encouraging to know: there is something that never changes. When everything around you seems to be always changing, Jesus offers help that never

changes, but may require a change of perception on our part.

God may not give us an easy road to the promised land, but he will give us a safe one---change. In life and death, Jesus provides us with a blessed assurance that he will never leave us and will ultimately bring us home. David, the Psalmist speaks of God's traveling mercies in Psalm 121. (read)

Elliptical hermeneutics is a term used to describe things unwritten, but expressed in the text. Behind this text, there is a question we all, at some time in our lives, ask ourselves:

Where can I find help in times of need? When pressure is brought to bear ones circumstances, and we feel the pain of life is too much to handle, it is good to know there is sure help in times of need! David opens this text with the answer to this question. When life offers no hope and seems overwhelming, David suggest we lift up our eyes to the hills from whence cometh our help. The only true help we can depend on comes from the Lord which made heaven and earth. Many of our ancestors were not afforded the multiplicity of options that are available to us today. So when they had to face Though thy beginning was small, yet thy latter end should greatly increase. [Job 8:7]

the perils, dangers, toils and snares, they knew to obtain assistance, they must keep God in their view as their divine watchman. Faith in God was not optional, for them to survive life's everyday struggles, they had to trust God to protect them at all cost.

This is the reality of our redemption in the Lord, as we travel along the way. It describes God as our helper. That text reminds us how God, was, is, and always will be a helper.

First, our text reflects on how our *help* comes from the God of creation.[v2] Can we wrap our minds around the fact that our help comes from the Lord which made heaven and earth. [Genesis 1:1] The same God that opened the curtain on all creation has made himself available to help you. The book of Hebrews says he is still upholding all creation by the Word of Power [Hebrews 1:3] This is the kind of dynamite power that will help us in our times of need. The God that had the power to create the beginning, is certainly able to re-create in the end. If he formed man from the dust of the earth in the beginning, He can raise him from the dust in the end. He is Eloheim, the God to whom all power belongs, and he will help us today if we look to Him.

Second, out text describes our helper as the God of preservation. David declared, God is a keeper, "He will not suffer thy foot to be moved...the Lord is thy keeper..." [v3-6] Three times the psalmist mentions the word keep in keep form. То some means to hedge about, to guard, to protect, to attend to. God is so obsessed with keeping you that He is nocturnal. That simply means He stays up all night long watching over us to attend to our needs. I do not know about you, but if God says He is awake, you might as well go to sleep! The God of creation is also the God of preservation and our source of help when we need to be kept.

Finally, out text proclaims our God will help us get delivered. We have help from the God of salvation. [v7,8] Someone may be saving, I do not see the word salvation in the text The psalmist called him Lord four times in this entire text. The word Lord is translated in Hebrew, Yahweh or Jehovah - He is the God of Israel who delivers, redeems, and saves. Our help comes from our creator, our preserver, and most of all our savior. When you are in trouble, Heaven promises not only to get you out, but will save you in the trouble. God is our present help in the time of trouble. Salvation did not get Daniel out of the Lions den, but delivered him in the Lion's den. King Nebuchadnezzar also testified to the salvation of the Lord by saying, " Lo, I see four men loose, walking in the midst of the fire, and they have no hurt." [Daniel 3:25] Help gets in the fire with you and brings you out. He does not dodge the valley of the shadow of death, but takes us through it.

Here is the amazing thing (Continued on page 18)

Summary




