#### Joshua 1:1-3

Now after the death of Moses the servant of the Lord it came to pass, that the lord spake unto Joshua the son of Nun, Moses' minister, saying, 2 Moses my servant is dead; now therefore

arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, even to the children of Israel 3 Every place that the sole of your foot shall tread upon, that have I given unto you, as I said unto Moses.

he history of Israel is very interesting and very compelling as we try to understand the track that God was using to bring the Children of Israel into their place of promise. We are moved by their history as we find Israel enslaved under the Egyptian rule for over 400 years. God's elect are now the slaves and prisoners under Egyptian Hand. God now raises up a young man named Moses, in the house of Pharaoh, to be the deliverer of Israel. It is very interesting because even though Israel has been labeled and tagged as God's Chosen people, God allows them to find themselves in a compromising position, not for 10, 20, or even 100 years, but now 400 years.

God allows Israel to remain in an uncomfortable state for 400 years, proving God is more interested in development than comfort.

God finally raises a young man of power to be the deliverer of His people. Moses has

been given charge of more than three million people. He then identifies certain challenges that forces him to have dialogue with God. Life has a way of pushing us into a conversation with God. Israel was God's chosen people, which means they should have been familiar with the customs and creeds of Judaism. But to Moses surprise, he finds a people who are knowledgeable about Jehovah God, but have no personal relationship with God. They only have a vicarious relationship with a God who calls them His children.

Israel's lack of relationship with God created a problem for Moses. When God began to deal with Israel, unless they had a mediator, He was always faced with a challenge or struggle moving them from one place to the other. Israel felt they needed to see everything that God was doing. They did not know Him for themselves, so there lies the formula for distrust. They knew Him

through the Patriarchs and Matriarchs of old. Beloved you cannot move in God if your basis of trust is someone else affirmation of God. This is a crisis because many times, God will not speak to anybody else but you. Israel's problem was this, if they could not see what God was doing, then they did not believe that God could do it. Consequently, they found themselves murmuring and complaining about everything they did not understand.

God's desire now is to move Israel from a place where they knew God, vicariously, to a place where they knew God emphatically for themselves. The dilemma is when you do not know God for yourself, you will always deal with God on the basis of eyesight. The Bible says "we walk by faith, not by sight." [II Corinthians 5:7] So, it is always God's desire to move you from the realm of eyesight to the realm of Faith. You can never deal with God with your natural eyes. You must deal with God on the basis of the heart or Spirit. We live in a world that requires that things must pass the "eye test" as if it is the basis of truth. God wants His

people to complete His desired plan. If you are going to walk with God in integrity, then you must allow God to transition your soul to embrace His vision. Eyesight limits you to the physical carnal realm, but when you deal with vision you also deal with the eternal spiritual realm. When nothing in our present looks like our promise, it pushes you to believe the Word of Faith you received in your heart. Anyone of us would agree that the reason we are still holding on is not because we already have the

answer to our prayers, but we know in our heart God is going to work it out!

God gave us vision for our future when He gave us His word. The interesting thing is, although He begins with vision, God does not complete His work at the level of vision. After he moves us into the realm of vision, He must then move us into the realm or dimension of insight. One of the problems with the church is many desire to know what God is doing, but we fail to lay before Him long enough to get the insight (on how God is going to do it). Vision tells us what He is going to do, but insight tells us how He is going to get it Therefore, we don't done. praise God based on a situation, but revelation received from the Word of God.

understand that it's not about what we see with our natural eyes, but it is more about what God says in our ears. Faith does not come by seeing, but Bible Faith comes by hearing and hearing by the Word of God. [Romans 10:17] Some of you should be "coo-coo for coco puffs," with everything the enemy has thrown your way. But you are not moved, because you believe what God says. So, if God says, in all things you are more than a conqueror; or, all things work together for your good, we must believe what God has said. Like the Apostle Paul who said, "I believe God!" [Acts 27:25]

So, we see here God is trying to move His people into a new dimension, where we walk by faith. Once we master this concept, it will intensify our worship experience. You will finally come to the place where your praise and worship is no longer tied to your situation. There is a disconnect with individuals who only praise God when they have money or everything is "fine" in their lives. Your praise and your worship cannot be tied to your external situation. No matter how dire

the situation, God is still God and worthy to be praised. One can compromise the integrity of worship by predicating your worship on external things. God is more concerned with your spiritual development than what you are going through; whether or not you have determined in your heart, that your praise is not tied to your situation but to Him.

In our text, Israel is struggling because they are a people who are bound by their physical situation that seemed hopeless. Bound in their freedom, because they cannot break free from their captivity. This still seems to be one of the greatest struggles in the church today, allowing what they are faced with to deter their Faith in God's ability to deliver. Thus. too many people have settled for mediocrity refusing to change and move forward. Where there is no vision, people usually give up or in to their situation and don't like to think outside of the box. The danger is many times we limit the creative Power of God. Moving in Faith allows us to get a revelation of God's plan so we can declare: "There is something better for me than this!"

Moses is challenged by this as he moves Israel. He is trying to let them know that even though you have been here 400 years this is not your destiny. You must be careful not to let the enemy deceive you, when you find yourself in a situation a long time. Satan wants you to believe that is God's will for you. I want to let you know our God is progressive; always moving. Ezekiel saw Him as a wheel in the middle of a wheel. Jacob saw Him moving as angels ascending and descending. So, when you find yourself stuck in a place, it is a compromise of the integrity of God's character. Always believe God will move you to your next level. This is who God is. [Genesis 1:2]

Moses is leading a people with purpose, but they have been abused so long their desire and drive has been defeated. So, he ends up trying to force them out of a place they should have been very excited about leaving. How many of us can relate to similar stages in our lives when God was impressing on you to go for your dream, but because of complacency we struggled to obey God?

Moses now is dealing with a

church that is comprised of churches that has formed within itself. He is dealing with cliques within the organization. You have to be careful of these spiritual wonders who come into ministries thinking they are junior pastors. This type of person will host unsanctioned Bible studies and private prayer meetings within their homes. Since they won't pay the cost to have their own church, they will start one in yours. Moses has a major problem because he has three churches within one church. This is a problem because God always speaks to the head-down, never from the bottom up. That would be a perverted anointing. Those who would operate under the anointing must be mature, whereas immature Christians can spell death to a move of God. Moses had too many people with their own agenda, thus the plan of God was hindered.

When you step with the Lord, you don't have an opinion, He again is Lord. When people are very opinionated, they are usually comfortable in captivity. If you are sitting under the Word, and you have not allowed God to move you to a new place in Him, you

must be satisfied with bond-Moses struggles with age. Israel's transition, as he brought them out to a new place, but not their final place. This transitional phase is called the Wilderness. On your way to your destiny, you must go through the wilderness experience. Moses had a group of individuals that took the position of "we will not be moved." They believed they were better off in Egypt in captivity. They believed their wilderness process was their demise. They did not understand that with vision, there is always provision. When you are in transition from now to then, God will always give you things that would not sustain you in any other place. God now gives them manna, which translates to "what is this?" God's provision will always sustain you in the process, understanding this not permanent.

Moses is trying to move a people who are not content within themselves. When things that are bad for you, start looking good, you require a strong leader. That is why God will always raise up a leader with a Word of Deliverance in his mouth. A word that will move you from Egypt to your place of promise. This second group Moses deals with is the lovers of the wilderness. They were glad to be out of Egypt, but satisfied with the place of process. Understand, a process still denotes movement. God never intended for us to get stuck in the process. The wilderness process is designed to mature you, to assist you in your growth. The process is designed to help you handle the predestinated blessing from God. The process can metaphorically be described as God's classroom. It is a series of testing and examinations. It is where you sit before the Lord to learn and understand what's in your heart. A series of uncomfortable testing to determine where you stand in Christ, hopefully, never becoming complacent. These people became satisfied with hanging out in the wilderness. Watch out for people who never want to move to the next level, who want to do the same thing over and over.

Israel tried to move with God, but were crippled by religion. In the 40 years in the wilderness, God always told them to build tents, never did He want them to use brick and mortar. Why? He wanted them to be able to move in an instant as the Spirit of God led. So God gave them a cloud, He wanted Israel to move with the cloud. How many times did they set up their tent in the morning, only to pack it up by evening. This was a type of teaching the people how to move with the Spirit. It's not about church government or tradition it's about you possessing the anointing of God.

Israel continued marching in a circle for 40 years and never realizing the hour of process was over. Whenever God tells you to move, to stand still is to remain is a sin. You must have a discerning spirit developed through God's word, to know if it is God or man leading. In my sanctified imagination, Moses began to cry out in exasperation, "there must be another set of people!" Remember, the first group of people were satisfied with being in bondage. The second group were content to be "stuck" in the process. Now God raises up a third group of people who desires to enter the promise. God always has a remnant who can believe God, hear His voice and see

beyond their current situation. The curtain rises on two boys by the name of Joshua and Caleb who had another spirit. They spied out the promised land with ten other spies. The spies bought back an evil report, while Joshua and Caleb declared the Lord is with us and we are more than enough to seize the promise land. They refused to be influenced by the crowd, but rather desired to move with God. Joshua and Caleb were movers and shakers, because they were connected to God.

God allowed Joshua and Caleb the right to enter into the promised land because they were willing to move their feet. All who refused to move perished in the wilderness, they died in their process. 

### Summary
