made accusations based on what he saw Job do regularly. He watched Job purifying his children, rising up early in the morning to offer burnt offerings for all of them. Job did this because he thought his kids had sinned and cursed God in their hearts. Satan is also watching and studying us, trying to get some dirt on us but whatever accusations he comes up with, **let it not be so!!!** (Job 1:11, John 8:44)

Job had it going on, he was blessed, naturally and spiritually. The bible says Job was the greatest man among all the people in the east. We can see why Satan thought he had Job figured out because most people with his status probably would have e been exactly as he said. Satan didn't believe what God said about Job because he was going by Job's actions, but the bible says, "Man



looks at the outside but God looks at the heart." [1 Samuel 16:7] Loving and serving God is personal, it's a heart issue and no one knows our heart like the Father. Even though God had blessed Job and his family, his children did not have the same heart towards God. tude. People are involuntarily serving the enemy, yet enjoying it. But the bible did tell us that sin is good for a season. [Hebrews 11:24-26] People are blinded and drawn away to sin by their own lust and enticed. [James 1:14] This is what I meant when I said people enjoy being in bondage. Job's children were in a blessed place but deception and probably some rebellion was also present. Isn't it funny how the enemy tries to make our blessed place look like a cursed place? All the time his agenda is to get us out of the will of God. We have all been there, especially when we were in the world doing our own thing and having a good time, so we thought. We didn't know we were involuntarily serving promoting Satan's agenda.

Satan has placed all sorts of influences, snares and traps around us. For us to fall into predicaments that we later regret. The lust of the flesh, the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life will lead us into places of involuntary servi-

tude. [1 John 2:16] Remember sin will always take us further

than we want to go, cost us more than we want to pay, and keep us longer than we want to stay. Have you ever found yourself doing something not on your agenda for that day, that's no coincidence? Something or someone persuaded you to do it. Remember the enemy studies us, just like he did Job. And he knows what and who to put in our paths to throw us off course. We think we get up every morning and make decisions of what we want to do; Satan is always on duty, waiting for the right moment to interrupt up our day. That is why acknowledging and seeking God daily is so vital. Have you ever seen a commercial before walking out the door that seduced you to do something that was not on the agenda? Although God was dealing with you about exercising and eating healthier, we swung into the IHOP parking lot because of the commercial- instead of obeying God's voice. SAY IT AIN'T SO!!! Satan is subtle, he doesn't overwhelm us with sin because he would get shut down. He uses one

bait at a time until we're caught, hooked, line and sinker. And if God does not help us, we will find ourselves out of control. Which voice will we obey, God or our belly? Deuteronomy.30:19 says, "I have set before you, life and death..... choose life" I know we don't think it's that serious but the next decision we make can be a life or death decision. Adam and Eve didn't think the forbidden fruit would cause the damage it did; and we are still suffering today.

The word bondage makes us think about a person in chains and in a dark place. Slave is not a word many want to be associated with but the bible says we are slaves in Christ. [Romans 6:18] It seems like we are free agents, running the show but we're not. We are like puppets on a string and whoever we yield our members to is our master. In the right state of mind, nobody enjoys being in bondage outside of Christ. And that is the battlefield, our mental state of mind. The GO-SPEL is a spell, or bondage I don't mind being controlled by. Many have ruined their lives and the lives of others think-

life..." Choosing life is not a onetime decision, we have to choose life daily.


Even though God says in His word, that His ways are not our ways, neither His thoughts our thoughts," why do we get discombobulated when the unexpected happens and start feeling some type of way towards God? 

our culture of the 21st century we experience a variety of topics that are controversial: Abortion, Sexual Orientation, Churches, Taxes, Climate Change, Gun Laws and Control, Drones, Gay Marriages, Medical Marijuana, and Obama Care/Health Care Laws, just to name a few, but the list goes on.

The title "MY CONTRO-VERSY IS MY CONFIR-MATION" further solidifies that controversy has its pros and cons, but few people view it as a confirmation in their life. Usually when controversy breaks out in the life of a believer the first school of thought is "THIS HAS TO BE THE DEVIL." Every expression of opposing views or differing of opinions is an opportunity to step back and evaluate the facts versus the truth.

The great man of faith, Abraham, was called out of idolatry, worshipping a God he could see, into believing in a God he could not see, which was and is controversial. Abraham does not just experience controversy in his belief, but also in his obedience.

In Genesis 12 God calls Abraham out of the place of familiar, Haran, into the place of unfamiliar (the place of Canaan). In the call he is instructed to leave his country and his relatives. Abraham faced with the controversy to leave relatives, now makes a decision to bring with him at least one relative, his nephew

Lot. The controversy of wars and outgrowth of land and disputes between servants became prevalent in the life of Abraham because he brought Lot with him; however it did not change God's mind about the journey to Canaan.

Sometimes we will take a problem with us when instructed by God not to, and God who is faithful will still give us the promise.

Abraham's wife, Sarah who is barren at the moment invokes a problem by giving Abraham permission to sleep with Hagar, her bondwoman, and they produced a son called Ishmael. Now Ishmael becomes what you think is the promise...but God does not need manipulation on our

part to produce what He has promised, it only delays the promise.

Time passes, Sarah becomes pregnant and gives birth to Isaac; the promise. Now her problem and her promise grow up together, and your mistake now mocks your miracle.

Sarah demands the bondwoman and her son be cast out!

Now there is controversy in the home and God confirms that the bondwoman and her son must be removed, but He makes a promise to Abraham that the son of the bondwoman will become a nation, because he is his seed.

Time continues to pass and Isaac becomes a man, forty years of age and is given a wife by the name of Rebekah. Sarah dies at one hundred twenty seven years old; Abraham remarries, and her name is Keturah and she bears children to Abraham. Scripture now embarks upon Isaac's life with Rebekah.

Genesis 25:19-25 New King James Version This is the genealogy of Isaac, Abraham's son. Abraham begot Isaac. Verse 20 Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah as wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padan Aram, the sister of Laban the Syrian. Verse 21 Now Isaac pleaded with the Lord for his wife, because she was barren; and the Lord granted his plea, and Rebekah his wife conceived.

Genesis 25:22

But the children struggled together within her; and she said, "If all is well, why am I like this?" So she went to inquire of the Lord. Verse 23 And the Lord said to her:

"Two nations are in your womb,

Two peoples shall be separated from your body;

One people shall be stronger than the other,

And the older shall serve the younger."

Verse 24 So when her days were fulfilled for her to give birth, indeed there were twins in her womb. Verse 25 And the first came out red. He was like a hairy garment all over; so they called his name Esau. Verse 26 Afterward his brother came out, and his

hand took hold of Esau's heel; so his

name was called Jacob. Isaac was sixty years old when she bore them.

The scripture gives us a picture of the promised child, Isaac praying for his wife Rebekah who is barren to become pregnant. The Lord grants his request and Rebekah becomes pregnant. Isaac does not settle for the situation the way it is, he does not say it is what it is, knowing that God has given us the ability to call those things that be not as though they are. He takes a position of controversy in another world. He does not contend in the natural or seen world, but he goes into opposition in the spirit world.

The promise child now marries a woman with a problem. Rebekah brings a barren problem to the table, and the promise does not get upset, he does not get mad and use tactics of the flesh to manipulate the spirit, but he does what he has been taught from his father, he begins to pray. He prays because he has to produce a people and the prayer in the spirit can open a barren womb in the natural.

Who better than Isaac to know this since he was the product of a barren woman? In Ministry there are promises God has given us and we find ourselves in barren places, planting fertile seed and producing absolutely nothing. The key is to work the realm of the spirit in order to produce in the natural. This is what Isaac did.

Isaac does not allow the controversy of barrenness for nineteen years to cause him to become discouraged, weary, or even hopeless; he does not give up, nor does he give out, but he perseveres until the controversy is ended.

Rebekah becomes pregnant and she experiences Hyper Emesis Gravidanum-a medical term for acute morning sickness. This is a possible indicator that a woman maybe pregnant with twins. It is a feeling of nausea and vomiting that can occur in the early stages of pregnancy. It, as uncomfortable as it is, is believed to be a good thing. It appears to be associated with a reduced risk of miscarriage and a greater chance that the pregnancy will have a healthy outcome. There lies





Summary

Fellowship with family - Father [v3] = Fellowship with Adam
