Fingerprinting


The Maine Principals Association has mandated that all officials in all high school sports be required to take and pass the Maine Department of Education background check this year. Accordingly, if you do not have evidence of having a current ME DOE background check, you will not be assigned by WMBUA for school baseball games beginning in the Spring 2020.

The following is the address of the ME DOE webpage that explains the background check / fingerprinting program, provides the application form, and links you to the fingerprinting appointment scheduler at IdentiGO sites: https://www.maine.gov/doe/cert/fingerprinting

What to do once you had the fingerprints taken:

- (1) Go to the: https://neo.maine.gov/doe/neo/TeacherCertification/ TeacherCertification
- (2) Fill in "Personal Details" (Last Name, Last 4 Digits of SSN and Date of Birth)
- (3) Click on Submit and your will get your results.

Your results should look like the picture below. Take a snapshot or print screen and send it to WMBUA, 23 Hearn Road, Scarborough, ME or email to: wmbuA.go.nutlook.com no later than March 15, 2020.
