On January 15, 1908, at Howard University, in Washington D.C., Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority, Incorporated, became America's first Greek-lettered organization. It was established by and for black women on the principles of high scholastic achievement and service to the community.

Zeta Nu Omega Chapter, was established under the same principles in March 1955, as a community-based service organization to meet the scholastic and community needs of the residents of Westchester County, in New York.

Alpha Kappa Alpha Sorority Inc., Zeta Nu Omega Chapter, established ZNO Community Service Fund, Inc., to offer scholarships in the amount of One Thousand dollars (\$1,000) to students who reside or attend high school within Westchester County, in New York.

We are requesting your assistance in identifying talented, creative and academically advanced students, whom you believe are committed to community service and would benefit from this scholarship.

Academics and Community Service will be the two main criteria upon which students will be evaluated.
