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Foster Agreement

The following binding legal agreement between AZ Pug Life Rescue Society ("AZ Pug Life Rescue",
"APLRS", "we") an Arizona non-profit organization, and you, herein referred to
as the "Foster" or "you" agree to the following:
You agree that the dog described in the Medical Records and Intake is the sole property of
APLRS and we are the rightful owners of said dog at all times during the foster period. The Foster
further understand and acknowledges that you have no right or authority to keep or place the dog in
any other home, or with any other individual, or in boarding without express permission of the
Executive Board of APLRS.
You understand and agree that any medical expenses must be approved by the President or
Vice President of APLRS, including routine vaccinations, initial vetting and dental procedures, the dog
must be taken to an approved veterinarian in the APLRS network with the exception of a life
threatening emergency such as continued seizures, car accident, difficulty breathing or serious
bleeding. You agree that you will continue to attempt to contact the APLRS representative in an
emergency until contact is made.
You agree that any approved out of pocket expenses will be reimbursed within 15 days of
presentation of receipt for the expenses to the Treasurer. Any expenses not approved or incurred at a
vet not in the APLRS network will be the foster's responsibility.
You agree that APLRS will not be responsible for medical or other expenses incurred for other
animals in the foster household regardless of cause, (ie. fight, mange, kennel cough.)
You agree that all personally owned cats and dogs in the foster home are or will be spayed or
neutered (exception can be made with Executive Board approval for special situations such as age or
allergy to anesthetic.)
You agree to only administer medication approved by APLRS and/or an approved APLRS
veterinarian. This includes but is not limited to flea and heartworm medication, vitamin supplements,
benadryl or aspirin. You further agree to administer the medications prescribed as directed on the
Medical Records and Intake form. Any other personal pets in the home must be up to date on
vaccinations/heartworm and paperwork attesting to this available upon request (exceptions can be
granted by the Executive Board of APLRS in certain cases.)

You agree to take this foster into your home and give the dog, a safe place, treat it as a family	
pet, to never leave the dog outside or unsecured when leaving the home. You agree the dog will be	
on a leash when in an unsecured area with the proper collar or harness and wearing the APLRS	
identification tag at all times. You further agree that the dog will be supervised with any visitors or	
children, and under your control when meeting new people or animals. It is highly recommended and	
good practice to secure a foster dog separately from any other animals in the home when	
unattended. You understand and accept the risks should you choose not to comply with this policy	
and may be liable for harm to the foster dog should it be harmed or die due to negligence.	
One of the primary goals of fostering is to help a foster dog become adoptable. Some cases	
will be medical, some behavioral. The foster agrees to work with the foster dog in all aspects towards	
these goals including but not limited to crate training, doggy door training, basic behavioral	
commands. You agree to not use harsh training methods, to never physically or emotionally abuse	
the foster dog and to not let anyone else in the household visitor or resident physically or emotionally	
abuse the foster dog.	
You agree to provide regular grooming such as bathing, nail trimming, clean nose fold, or anal	
gland expression at your own cost or to make arrangements with Laura Russell through Villa la Paws.	
You further agree to not alter the dog's appearance in any way such as shaving, ear or tail cropping	
or declawing.	
You agree to make the dog available to adoption events in the Phoenix Metro Area, either by	
attending in person, or arranging transportation with another APLRS volunteer or board member. If	
attending the event you are representing APLRS, and agree to comply with the event/volunteer dress	
code.	
You agree to make the foster dog available to potential adopters by either meeting at a	
convenient location, going to their home, or having potential adopters come to your home with prior	
notice.	
If at any point you can no longer foster a particular dog, you agree to give APLRS adequate	
time to locate and place the dog in another home. You agree any equipment borrowed from APLRS	
for this foster will be returned at the same time. If at anytime you are no longer able or willing to be a	
foster for APLRS any equipment loaned or borrowed from the organization will be returned within	
seven days or on surrender of last foster animal in the home.	
You agree to immediately notify an APLRS Executive Board Member in the case that the foster	
dog is lost, stolen or dies. If the foster dog is lost, stolen or dies, APLRS will not hold the Foster	
responsible and releases the Foster from any claim arising these circumstances.	
If you are a renter you agree to provide on request permission by landlord/management	
company documentation of permission to have animals, deposits or pet rent. If at any time your	

address or contact information changes you agree	ee to contact APLRS immediately. A renters or
homeowners insurance policy for liability is highly re	ecommended.
Foster homes are subject random inspection	s for safety and well being of the foster dog.
Foster dogs are eligible for adoption by the fo	ster home, the procedures and fees are the same
for any individual seeking to adopt the foster dog. A	A determination will be made APLRS for each dog

You understand and accept that APLRS make	ces no representations or warranties regarding the

dog and fully accept the risk, with this in mind, you agree and all rights or claims for damages, injuries, costs, or lia	•
