
Over the nine week period (3rd July - 1st Sept) your children will grow a range of herbs, vegetables and flowers. Not only will they grow them, they will learn about them, draw them and taste them! There will be plenty of activities and, of course, they will take their produce home.

**Drop off – 7-8.30am.** Activities (games and quizzes) start from 7am with timetabled tasks (see schedule below) commencing at 8.30am.

**Lunch - 11am-12 noon.** Drinks, sandwiches with salad will be provided to those children who are having lunch provided by us. For others, please provide a packed lunch. Unfortunately, we are unable to cater for children with special dietary requirements. Please provide a packed lunch for those children.

**Collection - 2-3pm.** Any late collection will be subject to additional fees of BD\$20 for every 30 minutes, or part thereof, payable immediately.

Please understand that your child is not officially enrolled in their week of choice until we receive your deposit. We accept major credit cards (sorry, not American Express), cheques, and cash.

Withdrawal and Missed Days. This is a small and specialist summer activity. There will be no refunds, unless we or you are able to fill the allocated space.

We expect respectful, safe and gentle behavior at all times as we aim to provide a fun learning environment. Any misbehaviour will be reported to parents/guardians. Continued disruptive behaviour will lead to the child's exclusion. No refund will be given.

You or named carers must collect your children. We will ask for ID.

We will provide all seed trays, seeds potting mix etc.

Please ensure your children are suitable dressed. They will be spending some time in our herb garden so please ensure they have hats etc.

Deposit. 50% of the total Required Weeks (see below) is payable on 1st June. The remaining 50% is payable on 3rd July.
