## **Religious Education Registration Information 2018-2019**

## Elementary and High School Registrations must be turned in by July 1<sup>st</sup>, in person to the office or mailed in to St Anthony's, PO Box 425, KS, LA 70750.

**Fees:** \$20.00 per student, if **3** or more in one family **\$** 15.00 each. Fees pay for books and supplies for the students and are necessary.

Materials to bring to every class: a pocket folder with clips, containing 20 – 30 -sheets of loose leaf paper. We provide pencils and pens as well as crayons.

## Attendance:

**Elementary:** There are only 24 hours of instruction – students will be present for all classes except in the event of serious illness. Bring in a copy of Dr.'s excuses, and make arrangements with the teacher to make up all work. If a student does not attend, they will be required to repeat the grade level the following year and will not be eligible to receive sacraments the during current year.

**High School: ALL High School students are preparing for the sacrament of Confirmation. All will** complete 20 spiritual and 20 community hours (5 different activities) yearly to eligible to make confirmation in the 11<sup>th</sup> grade. All high school students will attend a Diocese required retreat. <u>Upon the 3<sup>rd</sup> Absence in high school</u>, the student is retained and will repeat the year.

**<u>Pick-up</u>**: Please, drop–off and pick-up students on time, not early or late. Teachers must be present at drop-off (wait for us to arrive) and they do have homes and families waiting for them and need to leave on time (please be prompt and in line so that we can move fast).

<u>Student Conduct/Discipline</u>: Volunteers, teachers and helpers, will receive the utmost respect and good conduct from students. Students who cause problems will be dismissed and not allowed to return without refund of the registration fee. NO ELECTRONCS OR CELLPHONES allowed and if found in use in they will be confiscated and returned to only parents – We have phones that can be used by students to call parents if needed.

We will provide snacks and drinks for the students during the Summer session.

<u>Student Dress</u>: Students should be dressed appropriately as if to be in church. Knee length shorts are OK for elementary students, but not high school, distressed jeans with holes, sagging pants, caps, sports or exercise clothing will not be allowed, and for safety – no open toe shoes or flip flops. Girls' skirts should be no shorter than 2-3 inches above the knee. No midriffs, low necklines, spaghetti straps, sheer, or halter style tops. Clothes should fit loosely. T-shirts are great as long as they do not contain vulgar, un-Christian, or derogatory print. Boys are not to wear earrings. Girls should wear only minimal jewelry. Parents will be called to bring appropriate clothing if needed. Appropriateness of dress will be determined by Father, the DRE, and /or the Catechists (teachers).

**Volunteers**: We need teachers and welcome volunteers, after receiving Safe Environment training. We need help to prepare crafts, help manage the flow of classes, practice music and prepare snacks for students. Please, ask how you can help! We do need you.
