



Renewal and Mission

Every Christian is called to evangelism, but we all need the Holy Spirit to empower us to play our part. This year's programme will seek to inspire and equip us to be joyful and effective witnesses, bringing the Good News to the world.



23rd June. GOOD NEWS FOR THE POOR: Revd. Andrew Micklefield Vicar of the Parish of the Resurrection in Alton will talk about how Christians can work together to bring good news to the needy, with local examples.



JESUS CHRIST: Charles Whitehead KSG A leading figure in Catholic Renewal, he will explain what is the Good News, and asking have we actually heard it?



28th July. GOOD NEWS AND GOSPEL: Mgr Canon Jeremy Garratt, former rector of St John's Seminary, Wonersh, will explain what the Bible tell us about why and how we should spread the Good News.



24th February. THE SPIRIT HAS **ANOINTED ME: Fr. Anthony Meredith** Vicar General of the Rosminians, will examine how the Holy Spirit inspires and empowers us to proclaim Good News.



18th August. THE CHURCH EXISTS TO EVANGELISE: Fr. Mark Hogan, Episcopal Vicar for Evangelisation in the Diocese of Portsmouth will explain the meaning and priority of mission, and the importance of the laity in this work.



24th March. LIVING KINGDOM VALUES: Jenny Baker, a gifted speaker and presenter of "CaFE" Catholic faith DVDs, will show how our everyday lives can become opportunities for witness.



22nd September. NEW SIGHT FOR THE **BLIND:** Pauline Edwards and Fr. Laurence **Brassill** founders of *Little Way Healing Ministry* will explain the role of healing in mission, taking the Good News to the spiritually blind.



28th April. SETTING THE DOWN-TRODDEN FREE: Peter Hobbs, who helps with Parish adult formation, looks at the importance of justice in mission, and Good News for modern day slaves.



27th October. THE SPIRIT HAS SENT ME: Fr. John Seddon. a Benedictine at Chilworth Abbey, where he leads monthly days of praise, will be looking at discerning how and where we are to respond to the call to evangelise.



19th May. PROCLAIMING THE LORD'S FAVOUR: Fr. Simon Penhalagan, President of the Sion Community explains how the Good News set us free from condemnation



24th November. LIBERTY FOR CAPTIVES: David Matthews, a popular speaker at Catholic charismatic Conferences and a former Protestant pastor, will talk on taking the Good News to prisoners and the spiritually oppressed.
