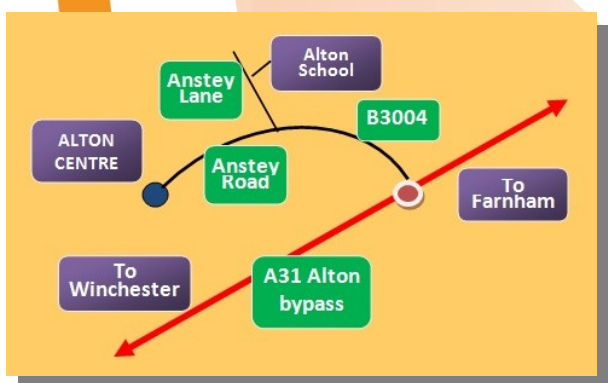

At Alton School, Anstey Lane, Alton GU34 2NG

(N.B. Ignore satnav once you get to Anstey Lane)

By car: From the A31 northeast of Alton, take the turning off at B3004 towards Alton; follow the main road for just under a mile, and Anstey Lane is on the right. After about 0.3 mile look out for the blue sign by the driveway to Alton School on the right. There is plenty of parking space.

By Train: Alton station is on the Alton Branch Line with services to Farnham, Woking and London Waterloo every half hour. To walk from the station, follow Station Road northeast until meeting Anstey Road. Turn right and proceed along Anstey Road for about 0.3 mile, then turn left on to Anstey Lane for about 0.3 mile and the school is on the right.
