

HEALING & DELIVERANCE SEMINARS WITH FR NICHOLAS BROADBRIDGE OSB

Fr. Nicholas Broadbridge has been a Benedictine monk at Douai Abbey for more than 60 years. He has run healing workshops, family healing session and retreats for the past 20 years and also offers spiritual direction. He was also spiritual director and chaplain to Alton Day of Renewal for many years.

Reflecting on themes of love and forgiveness, healing, deliverance and the gifts of the Spirit, Fr Broadbridge uses scriptural passages and many personal stories of those he has encountered during his ministry to illustrate his message that God longs to set free those who are oppressed.

The seminars take place at Elmore Abbey, RG14 1SA, Speen on the North West edge of Newbury. The quickest way from Reading is M4 to Junction 13, A34 as far as A4 for Newbury, (enlarge Google Map Speen) then immediately look on the right for Speen Lane (there is a stone monument as you start on Speen Lane). Church Lane on the right leads you to Elmore (Abbey on the gate)
