Grading Breakdown:

Final Proficiency Exam:

- 20% of your final grade; taken in June
- Passing this exam earns students 1 credit of High School World Language
- Earning a 90% or better on this exam is one criterion for admission into Honors French in High School.

Criteria for Admission into Honors French in High School: (Meet at least 2 of the following)

- 90% or higher average in the course
- 90% or higher score on the Final Proficiency Exam
- Teacher recommendation

Class Participation Expectations:

- Be respectful of your work, your classroom, your teacher, and your classmates.
- Arrive on time with all necessary materials.
- Always make an effort to speak French!
- Remember to "Be TRUE (Timely, Respectful, Understanding, and Engaged)"

Homework Policies:

- All homework is due at the **start** of class on the designated day.
