

- ❖ Rehearsals are mandatory. Many people rely on you to be here! Please let me know if you have a valid excuse to miss any rehearsal, or better yet - have your mom or dad e-mail me directly. (Ihoagg@northsalemschools.org)
- ❖ Our production is the Friday before Thanksgiving. We will perform for the 5th graders during the day, and in the evening at 7:30pm.
- ❖ 7TH and 8th graders: You cannot do both a fall sport and drama club.
- Our rehearsals end at 4:30 or 5:00 in the beginning and then go until 6 or 6:30 the week before. You must be able to provide your own transportation.
- We rehearse two to three days a week and then usually everyday two weeks before the actual production.
- A calendar will be given to you at our first rehearsal with all our rehearsal dates and times. Again, you really need to attend all rehearsals.
- ❖ We are all here to have fun, but ultimately you are here to put on a great performance. If you think Drama Club is an excuse to just hang out, fool around, or run around the school, you should not join our club. If I have to speak to you about inappropriate behavior more than twice, you will be asked to leave the club.
- * Remember: this is a group effort, and your <u>behavior</u> and <u>attitude</u> affects everyone!
