

Golf de Chiberta - Anglet, France



Chiberta is one of the great French examples of a links course, designed by the legendary Tom Simpson. Located in southwestern France, near the border of Spain, this course is one of the most rewarding courses in France, and provides a wonderful day of golf to all who play on it.

The original 1924 design has been well-preserved among the pine forests and dunes. The greens are excellent, and the hazards are clearly visible. Strategies are pretty obvious, and the absence of any real relief with the comfort of sandy soil makes for a pleasant walk. However, once the wind gets up Chiberta becomes a test where ball-control is essential, and where players with a tight short game will come into their own.
