WELCOME TO THE VEGETARIAN CLUB

The Vegetarian Club of Canton (VCC) was formed to teach, perpetuate and spread the principles of a healthy, plant-based, low-fat, low-cholesterol diet in the greater Stark County, Ohio area.

History of VCC

VCC was organized in September 1986 by local vegetarian David Kidd. The club has had a significant impact in Stark County, Ohio due to the work of dozens of member volunteers each year. One uniqueness of the VCC is that its goal from the beginning was to meet at a different restaurant each month for a vegan (non-dairy vegetarian) meal in a banquet setting. VCC has educated restaurant owners, food service managers, chefs, and wait staff on how to prepare quality vegan meals. While the learning curve is long, in its first 26 years, VCC has served over 13,000 vegan meals and has caused vegetarian & vegan meals to be placed on local restaurant menus.

Educational Presentations

Following our vegan dinner at monthly meetings, we offer regional and national speaker programs designed to teach the many facets of a vegetarian/ vegan lifestyle. Through these lectures, we cover the basics of why and how to eat a healthy plant-based diet. Lecture topics include, but are not limited to, research of social, economic, environmental, moral and ethical, and scientific health related aspects of a plant-based diet. VCC has also offered the School Nutrition Initiative (SNI), teaching school children how to eat healthy fruits and vegetables. These presentations are not limited to schools, but have also been given at business offices for the employee health and fitness programs.

Monthly Dinner Meeting

All dinners are served at 7 p.m. with the program beginning at about 8:00

p.m. Please be sure you are checked in and seated before dinner is served. You do not need to be a vegetarian or vegan to attend any of our meetings. One of our goals is to introduce new food ideas to those who want to learn how to eat a healthier diet.
